VINTAGE LACE COLLAR

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Neck Circumference (Buttoned): 19"

Depth: 9"

MATERIALS

Downton Abbey *Lady Mary* by Premier Yarns (95% Acrylic, 5% Metallic; 85 gm/29Oyds)

- #DA4004-07 Silver Frost - 1 ball

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, 3 - 3 ¼" buttons

GAUGE

20 dc = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.



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STITCH GUIDE

DCC - Double Crochet Cluster - [Yo, insert hk into indicated st or sp, yo, pull through 2 lps] twice, yo pull through all three lps on hk.

COLLAR

Ch 21, dc in 2nd ch from hk and in each ch across - 20 dc.

Row 1: Sc in next 12 dc, hdc in next 3 dc, dc in next 5 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in each st to end.

Rep Rows 1 & 2, 27 more times.

Buttonhole Loops (Make 3)

With RS facing, join yarn with a sl st in first dc in left front corner of Collar, ch 7, sk 2 dc, sl st in next dc to attach ch to collar to form button loop. Turn. Ch 1, 14 sc in ch-7 sp. Fasten off.

Rep Buttonhole Loop twice more, spacing loops evenly across left front edge.

Neck Border

With RS facing, join yarn with a sl st in top right corner, ch 1, sc evenly across neck edge.

Next Row: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Lace Edging

With RS facing, join yarn with a sl st in bottom right corner of Collar, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc 227 sts evenly across bottom edge. Approximately 4 sts placed in each row, plus 3 extra sts spaced evenly around.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc) dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, *dc in next 3 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc; rep from * to end, dc in last 3 dc.

Row 3: Ch 5, (counts as dc, ch 2), sk next dc, dc in next dc, *ch 2, sk ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * to end, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Row 4: Ch 2, *2 sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-2 sp, dc, (DCC, ch 4, DCC) in next ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-2 sp, dc, 2 sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next dc, rep from * to end working last sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

Row 5: Ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 4, sk next ch 4 sp, ([DCC, ch 4]3 times, DCC) in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-4 sp and sc, sc in next sc, *sc in next 2 sc, ch 4, sk next ch 4 sp, ([DCC, ch 4]3

times, DCC) in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sk next ch-4 sp and sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to end, sc in beg ch-2.

Row 6: Ch 6 (counts as sc, ch 4), sc in next ch-4 sp, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp]twice, ch 7, join with a sl st in 7th ch from hk, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp]twice, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in next sc, *[ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp]3 times, ch 7, join with a sl st in 7th ch from hk, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp]twice, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to end working last sc in beg ch-2.

Neck Edge

With RS facing, join yarn with a sl st in ch-4 loop of Row 6 of Lace Edging.

Ch 1, sc in next st or sp, ch 3, sl st in base of sc just worked, sc 2; rep from * spacing sts evenly across left front edge in front of Buttonhole Loops, neck edge and right front edge

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Sew buttons to right front. Block lightly.
