

Knit Wide Stripes Throw

Skill Level



EASY

Finished throw measures approximately 50" square.

Materials

Yarn: *Dream*™ by Premier® Yarns (100% acrylic, 3½ ounces/100 grams; 224 yards/205 meters per ball)

- 24-201 White (A) – 2 balls
- 24-218 Balsam (B) – 3 balls
- 24-216 Baby Fern (C) – 3 balls

Knitting Needles: US 8 (5mm) *or size to obtain gauge*

Extras: Yarn needle

Gauge: 16 sts and 24 rows = 4" in patt. *Use any size needles to obtain the specified gauge.*

Abbreviations

k – knit; *mm* – millimeter; *p* – purl; *rep* – repeat; *st(s)* – stitches; * – repeat instruction after asterisk as specified.



THROW

With A, cast on 200 stitches

Rows 1 through 13: Knit every row. Cut A at end of Row 13.

Row 14: With B, * k2, p2; rep from * across row.

Row 15: * P2, k2; rep from * across row.

Row 16: * P2, k2; rep from * across row.

Row 17: * K2, p2; rep from * across row.

Repeat Rows 14-17, 6 more times (41 total rows). Cut B.

Row 42 through 47: With A, knit each row. Cut A at end of Row 47.

Row 48: With C, * k2, p2; rep from * across row.

Row 49 * P2, k2; rep from * across row.

Row 50: * P2, k2; rep from * across row.

Row 51: * K2, p2; rep from * across row.

Repeat Rows 48-51 six times. Cut C.

Repeat Rows 14-51 three times.

Last 13 Rows: With A, knit every row.

Bind off all stitches loosely.

Finishing

Weave in ends.
