

## Stripy Popover

Level: Intermediate



### FINISHED SIZE

Length: 27"

Chest: 40"

### MATERIALS

**Deborah Norville Collection™** *Everyday Soft* Worsted by Premier® Yarns (100% anti-pilling acrylic, 113g/203 yds)

- #ED100-24 Steel (MC) – 4 skeins
- #ED100-17 Azure (CC1) – 1 skein
- #ED100-20 Orchid (CC2) – 1 skein
- #ED100-21 Magenta (CC3) – 1 skein

**Needle:** US Size 8 (5mm) 29" circular knitting needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** 2 Stitch markers, tapestry needle, 1" button, stitch holder or scrap yarn

### GAUGE

15 sts x 22 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### STITCH GUIDE

**1x1 Ribbing** (multiple of 2 sts)

**Row 1:** K1, p1; rep from \* across.

Rep Row 1 for patt.

**Stripe Sequence:** \* 4 rows MC, 2 rows CC2, 4 rows MC, 2 rows CC1, 4 rows MC, 2 rows CC3; rep throughout garment.

### PATTERN NOTES

Worked from sleeve to sleeve with increases for the body of the garment.

### POPOVER

#### Sleeve

With MC cast on 46 sts.

Begin Stripe Sequence.

Work in 1x1 Ribbing for 4".

**Inc Row:** Kfb, knit to last st, kfb.

Working in St st, rep Inc Row every 6<sup>th</sup> row 5 more times, then every 4<sup>th</sup> row 7 more times – 72 sts.

**Body** (continuing to follow stripe sequence)

Cast on 64 sts at beginning of next 2 rows – 200 sts.

Knit 6 rows.

**Begin St st**

**Row 1 (RS):** K6, pm, knit to last 6 sts, pm, k6.

**Row 2:** K6, sl m, purl to last 6 sts, sl m, k6.

Continue as established for 6”.

**Neck Opening and Front**

Work across 95 sts as established, bind off 10 sts, work across next 95 sts. Place first 95 sts on holder for Back.

Working across 95 sts for Front, work in patt as established for 4”, ending with a WS row.

**Next Row (RS):** Bind off 26 sts, work to end of row.

**Next Row (WS):** Work to end of row, cast on 26 sts.

Continue to work Front in patt as established for another 4”, ending with a WS row.

Place Front sts on holder.

**Back**

Place Back sts from holder onto needles, ready to work a WS row.

Work in patt as established until Back measures the same length as Front, ending with a RS row.

**Join Front and Back**

Place Front sts from holder onto other needle. Cast on 10 sts, knit across Front sts – 200 sts on needles.

Work in patt as established for 6”.

Knit 6 rows.

Bind off 64 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows – 72 sts.

**Sleeve**

Continuing in Stripe patt, working in St st, work 6 rows.

**Dec Row:** K2tog, work to last 2 sts, k2tog – 2 sts dec’d.

Rep Dec Row every 4<sup>th</sup> row 6 more times, then every 6<sup>th</sup> row 6 more times – 46 sts rem.

Work in St st until sleeve measures 13”.

Work in 1x1 Ribbing for 4”, ending with 4 rows of MC.

Bind off all sts.

**FINISHING**

Sew sleeve seams.

Sew side seams 4” down from armhole, leaving rest of sides open.

**Front Edging**

Beg at the right front neck edge (top of V-slit) with MC, pick up 92 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

**Rnd 1:** Purl.

**Rnd 2:** Knit to last 3 sts, bind off 3 sts.

**Rnd 3:** Purl around, cast on 3 sts.

**Rnd 4:** Knit.

**Rnd 5:** Purl.

Bind off all sts.

Sew 1” button opposite buttonhole.

Weave in ends.

**Abbreviations**

<b>beg</b>	beginning
<b>bet</b>	between
<b>CC</b>	contrast color
<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>kfb</b>	knit in the front and back of next st – 1 st inc’d.
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts tog
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>m</b>	marker
<b>MC</b>	main color
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	patt
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rem</b>	remain
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>RS</b>	Right Side
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>st (s)</b>	stitch, (es)
<b>St st</b>	stockinette stitch; knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
<b>tog</b>	together
<b>WS</b>	Wrong Side
