## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Premier Home ${ }^{T M}$ Cotton (85\% cotton, $15 \%$ polyester; $80 \mathrm{gm} / 140 \mathrm{yds}$ )

- \#38-14 Christmas Green (A) - approx. 40 yds
- \#38-07 Cranberry (B) - approx. 100 yds
- \#38-01 White (C) - approx. 100 yds

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Premier Home ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Cotton Marls ( $85 \%$ cotton, $15 \%$ polyester; $60 \mathrm{gm} / 105$ yds)

- \#76-01 Holiday (D) - approx. 100 yds

Hook: US Size H-8 ( 5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle
GAUGE
Rnds 1-2 = $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ across
Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

Picot: Ch 2, sc in last st made.

## WASHCLOTH

With A, ch 6, sl st to form a ring.
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ), 15 dc in ring, sl st in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-3 to join -16 dc .
Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), (dc, ch 1) in each dc around, sl st in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-4 to join, fasten off. 16 ch-1 sps.
Rnd 3: Join B in any ch-1 sp, [(sc, dc, sc) in next ch-1 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 6, sl st in $6^{\text {th }}$ ch from hk] around, sl st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}-8 \mathrm{ch}-6 \mathrm{sps}$.
Rnd 4: [SI st in next dc, ( 6 dc, picot, 6 dc ) in ch- 6 sp ] around, sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ sl st to join, fasten off -8 petals formed.
Rnd 5: With C and working behind petals just made, [sc in Rnd 2 ch-1 sp (next to dc from Rnd 3), ch 3, sc in center of Rnd 3 ch-6 lp (under picot), ch 3] around, sl st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$ to join $-16 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$.
Rnd 6: Ch 1, [sc in sc, ch 6, sl st in $6^{\text {th }}$ ch from hk, 3 sc in ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, 3 sc in ch-3 sp] around, sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ sc to join -8 ch- 6 sps .
Rnd 7: Ch 3, (4 dc, ch 2, 5 dc ) in ch-6 sp, sk 3 sc, sc in next sc, [(5 dc, ch $2,5 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-6 sp, sk 3 sc , sc in next sc ] around, sl st in top of beg ch-3 to join -8 petals formed.
Rnd 8: Cut C and join D, working behind petals just made, [ch 3, dc in ch-6 sp at center of petal, ch 3, sc in next sc, ch 3, sc in ch-6 sp at center of petal, ch 3, sc in next sc] around, do not join - 16 ch-3 lps.
Rnd 9: SI st in ch-3 sp, ch 1, [(sc, $2 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2$ ) in next ch-3 sp, (2 dc, $2 \mathrm{hdc}, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next ch-3 sp, 5 sc in each of next 2 ch-3 sps] 4 times, sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ sc to join.
Rnds 10-11: Ch 3 (counts as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ), [dc in each st to ch-2 sp, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-2 sp] 4 times, dc in each st to beg ch-3, sl st in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch-3 to join.
Rnd 12: Ch 1, sc in each dc to ch-2 sp, ( $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 10,2 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch-2 sp, [sc in each dc to ch-2 sp, 3 sc in ch-2 sp] 3 times, sc in each dc to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$, sl st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$ to join. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
