



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

9" x 9"

MATERIALS

Premier Yarns® Home Cotton (85% cotton, 15% polyester; 80g/140 yds)

- 38-03 Beige (MC) – 1 ball
- 38-16 Black (CC1) – 1 ball
- 38-06 Orange (CC2) – 1 ball

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 7 (4.5 mm)

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

14 sts x 14 rows = 4" in Linen St patt

Save time, check your gauge.

Directions:

STITCH GUIDE

Linen Stitch (*even number of sts*)

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, [ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next sc] to last st, sc in last sc, turn.

Rep Row 1 for patt.

Surface Slip Stitch Crochet

Hold yarn beneath work. Insert hook from RS of work to back and pull up a loop. * Insert hook from RS of work to back one row/stitch away, pull up a loop, pull this loop through loop on hook – 1 sl st made. Rep from * for each sl st.

WASHCLOTH

With MC & larger hook, ch 31.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hk and each ch across – 30 sc.

Rows 2-29: Work Row 1 of Linen St Pattern.

Row 30: Ch 1, sc in each sc and sp across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

With CC1 & CC2 and smaller hook, work Surface Slip Stitch Crochet along lines indicated in Diagram.

Edging

Attach CC1 at upper right corner.

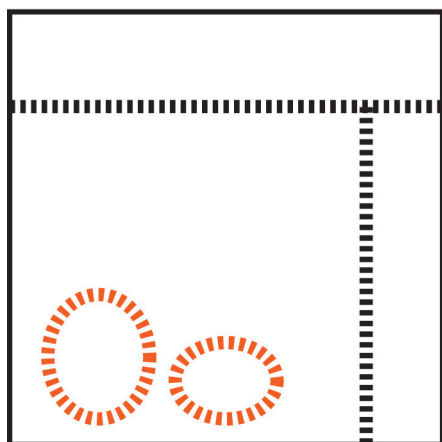
Rnd 1: With smaller hook, ch 1, sc in same sp, sc in each of next 28 sts, [work 4 sc in corner, work 28 sc evenly to next corner] 3 times, work 2 sc in same same sp as beg sc, ch 15 (for hanging loop), sl st in last sc made, sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Weave in ends and block.

Abbreviations

beg	beginning
ch	chain
CC	contrast color
hk	hook
MC	main color
rep	repeat
sc	single crochet
sk	skip
sl st	slip stitch
sp	space
st(s)	stitch(es)
