

# Winter Fan Washcloth

Level: Intermediate



#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

9" x 9"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Premier Home® Cotton (85% cotton, 15% polyester; 80gm/140 yds)

- #38-12 Turquoise (A) 1 ball
- #38-01 White (B) 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) straight needle *or size* 

needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, US Size H-8 (5mm)

crochet hook

#### **GAUGE**

18 sts x 28 rows = 4" in patt st Save time, check your gauge.

# **Directions:**

## **STITCH GUIDE**

**Fan Stitch** (multiple of 12 sts + 3)

Note: Stitch count changes on Rows 3-4 & 9-10.

**Row 1 (RS):** With B, k1, \* k5, sl 3 wyib, k4; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 2:** With B, p2, \* p4, sl 3 wyif, p5; rep from \* to last st, p1.

**Row 3:** With B, k1, \* k5, [sl 1 wyib, m1] twice, sl 1 wyib, k4; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4: With B, p2, \* p4, [sl 1 wyif, p1] twice, sl 1 wyif, p5; rep from \* to last st, p1.

**Row 5:** With A, k1, \* k4, k2tog, k3, ssk, k3; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 6: With A, knit.

**Row 7:** With B, k1, \* sl 2 wyib, k9, sl 1 wyib; rep from \* to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyib, k1.

Row 8: With B, p1, sl 1 wyif, \* sl 1 wyif, p9, sl 2 wyif; rep from \* to last st, p1.

Row 9: With B, k1, \* sl 1 wyib, m1, sl 1 wyib, k9, sl 1 wyib, m1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyib, k1.

**Row 10:** With B, p1, sl 1 wyif, \* p1, sl 1 wyif, p9, sl 1 wyif, p1, sl 1 wyif; rep from \* to last st, p1.

**Row 11:** With A, k1, \* k2, ssk, k7, k2tog, k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 12: With A, knit.

Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

## **PATTERN NOTES**

Carry unused color along side of Washcloth.

### **WASHCLOTH**

With A, cast on 39 sts.

Knit 2 rows.

Work in Fan Stitch until Washcloth measures 9" ending on Row 6 or 12 of patt.

With A, bind off all sts.

### **FINISHING**

## **Edging**

With crochet hook attach A at any corner. Work 1 round of single crochet around washcloth, working 15 chains at one corner for hanging loop. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

## **Abbreviations**

k knit

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

m1 insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)

p purlpatt patternrep repeat(ing)RS right sidesl slip

ssk slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)WS wrong sidewyib with yarn in backwyif with yarn in front
