**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS****Width:** 44"**Length:** 42"**MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Couture Jazz™ (81% Acrylic, 19% Nylon) 3.5 oz/100 g, 16.5 yds/ 15 m)

- #26-39 Ruby – 12 balls

Needle: US Size 50 (25 mm) 32" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Sewing needle & matching thread

GAUGE

3 sts x 4 rows = 4"

Gauge is not critical, work evenly throughout.**PATTERN NOTES**

The cleanest way to join a new ball of yarn is to use a needle and thread to sew the two ends together. Fold the last 1-2" of each end into the inside of the tube (so that the raw edge is hidden) and quickly whipstitch them together. Sew all of your skeins of yarn together at the start and roll them into one giant ball before you start knitting.

BLANKET

Cast on 33 sts.

Row 1: *K1, p1*; rep from * across.

Repeat Row 1 until piece measures 42" or until only 3 yards of yarn remain.

Bind off all sts in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in ends, using your fingers to push and pull the ends through the stitches. Use needle and thread to sew the ends in place in an inconspicuous spot.

Seed Stitch Blanket

Level: Easy

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

40" x 40" (excluding tassels)

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Serenity Chunky™ Ombre (100% acrylic; 8.2 oz/250 g, 273 yds/250 m)

- #1075-05 Baked Apple – 1 ball (A)
- #1075-06 Poppy – 1 ball (B)
- #1075-12 Walnut – 1 ball (C)

Premier® Yarns Serenity Chunky® (100% acrylic; 10.5 oz/300 g, 328 yds/300 m)

- #1061-10 Pristine – 1 ball (D)

Hook: US Size L (8 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, tassel maker

GAUGE

9 sts x 5 rows = 4" in Dc

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE**Simple Granny Square**

Start with a magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, [dc 2, ch 3, dc 3, ch 3, dc 3, ch 3, dc 3, ch 3] in the ring. Sl st to top of the first dc of the rnd.

Row 2: Ch 2, dc in each st around, working a [dc, ch 3, dc] in each corner.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

THROW

Start with a magic ring.

Setup Rnd: With A, work Rnd 1 of Simple Granny Square patt.

Rnds 1-16: With A, work Rnd 2 of Simple Granny Square patt.

Rnds 17-18, 26-27, 32 : With D, work Rnd 2 of Simple Granny Square patt.

Rnds 19-25: With B, work Rnd 2 of Simple Granny Square patt.

Rnds 28-31: With C, work Rnd 2 of Simple Granny Square patt.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Tassels

Using instructions provided by manufacturer, make 4 – 6" tassels in D.

Using the photo as a guide, attach one tassel to each corner of the throw.

Apple Tartlet Throw

Level: Easy



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 48"
Length: 56"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Serenity Chunky™ Ombre (100% acrylic; 8.2 oz/250 g, 273 yds/250 m)

- #1075-04 Aloe – 4 balls

Needle: US Size 11 (8 mm) 32" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

10 sts x 16 rows = 4" in patt
Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Alternating Chevron Stitch (*multiple of 10 sts*)

Row 1: *P4, k1, p1, k4*; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: *P3, k2, p2, k3*; rep from * to end of row.

Row 3: *P2, k2, p1, k1, p2, k2*; rep from * to end of row.

Row 4: *P1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k1*; rep from * to end of row.

Row 5: *K2, p3, k3, p2*; rep from * to end of row.

Row 6: *K1, p4, k4, p1*; rep from * to end of row.

Rep Rows 1-6 for patt.

BLANKET

Cast on 120 sts.

Work Alternating Chevron Stitch patt until blanket meas approx. 56", ending with Row 5.

Bind off in patt.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

k knit
meas measures

p purl
rep repeat(ing)
st(s) stitch(es)

Level: Easy



Yuletide Motif Throw

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 34"

Length: 50"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Serenity Chunky® (100% acrylic; 10.5 oz/300 g, 328 yds/300 m)

- #1061-03 After Dark – 2 balls (A)
- #1061-06 Wine – 2 balls (B)
- #1061-10 Pristine – 1 ball (C)
- #1061-04 Sand – 2 balls (D)

Hook: US Size L (11 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

6 puff stitches = 4" in Motif

1 Motif square = 8" x 8"

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Puff Stitch: [yo, insert hk, draw up a lp] 3 times (7 lps on hk), yo and pull through all lps, ch 1.

Cluster Stitch: [yo, insert hk, draw up a lp, yo and pull through 2 lps on hk] 4 times (5 lps on hk), yo and pull through all lps.

PATTERN NOTES

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

Motif Square Pattern:

With A(B), start with a magic ring.

Rnd 1: With A(B), ch 3 (counts as 1st dc here and throughout), dc 15 more into the ring, pull yarn tail to close circle. Sl st to the top of ch-3 to join. Cut A(B). – 16 dc

Rnd 2: With C, ch 1, work 1 puff st in same stitch and in each dc around, sl st to first puff st of rnd. Cut C. – 16 puff sts

Rnd 3: With B(A), sl st into next ch 1 sp, ch 2, *cluster st, ch 2* in the same ch-1 sp; rep from * into each ch-1 sp around, sl st into top of first cluster st. Cut B(A). – 16 cluster sts.

Rnd 4: With A(B), Sl st into the next ch-2 sp, [ch 4 (counts as 1st tr here and throughout), 2 tr, ch 3, 3 tr] in that same ch-2 sp, this forms your first corner. *3 dc in next ch-2 sp, 3 hdc in next ch-2 sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, [3 tr, ch 3, 3 tr] in next ch-2 sp*; rep from * twice more, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, 3 hdc in next ch-2 sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, sl st into the top of the beg ch-4. Cut A(B).

Rnd 5: With D, sl st into same st, ch-2 (counts as 1st hdc) hdc in each st around, working [1 hdc, ch 3, 1 hdc] into each ch-3 corner sp from the previous rnd. Sl st into top of the beg ch-2.

Fasten off.

THROW

Make 12 Motif Squares beginning with A.

Make 12 Motif Squares beginning with B.

Yuletide Motif Throw

Joining

Using the diagram as a guide, begin by holding 2 motif squares together and attach D in corner sp. Ch 2. Hdc in each hdc along the edge (working 2 hdc in both corner spaces).

Rep until you have 6 strips of motif squares, each 4 squares wide.

Using this same method, holding 2 of the motif square strips together, attach D in corner sp and ch 2. Hdc along the entire horizontal edge. Repeat this 4 more times.

Now, hdc along the 3 vertical edges that haven't been joined yet, making sure to evenly line up the intersections.

Fasten off.

Border

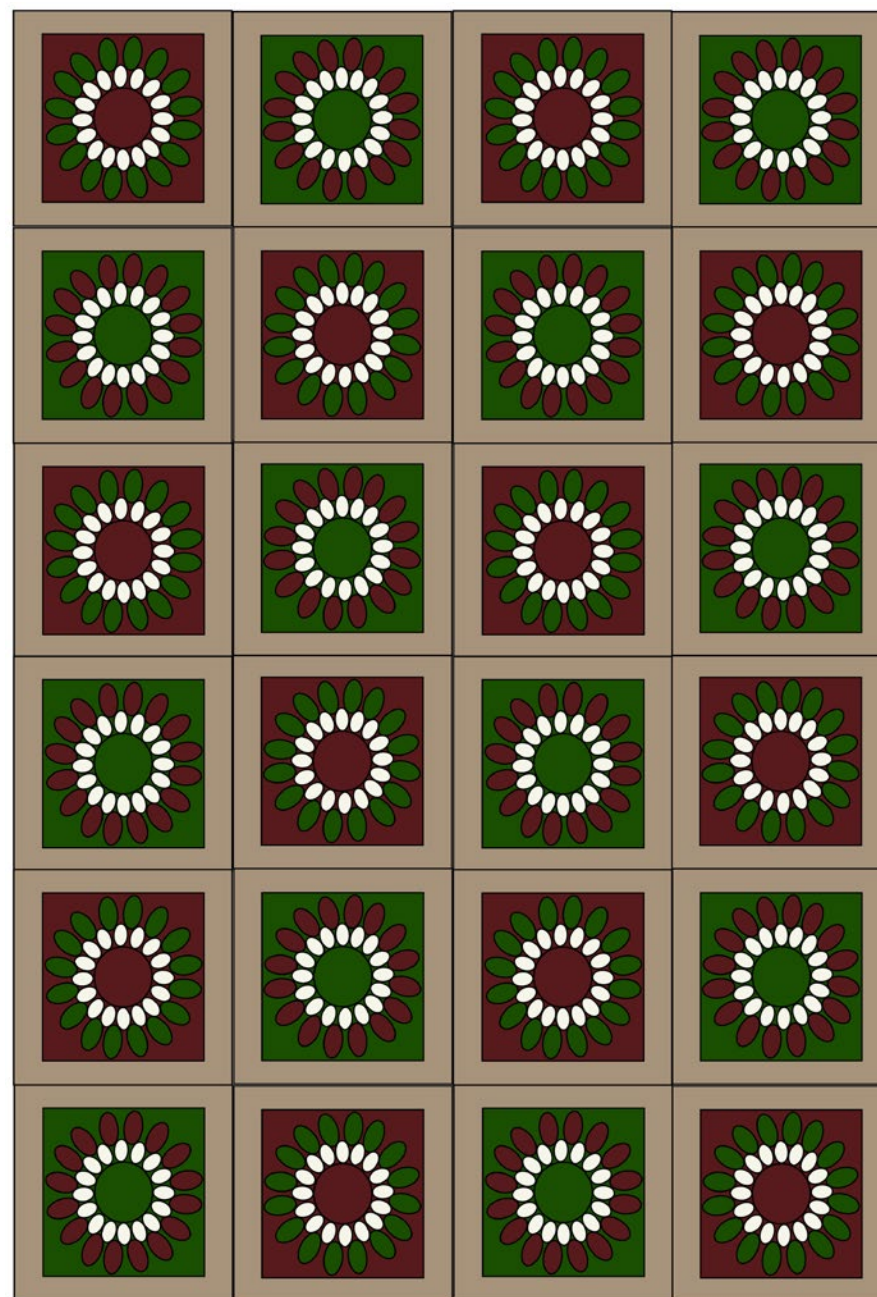
Attach D to any st, ch 2. Hdc in each st around, making sure to work [1 hdc, ch 3, 1 hdc] in each corner sp.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Merry & Bright Blanket

Level: Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 48"

Length: 56"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Serenity® Marl (100% acrylic; 270gm/295 yds)

- #1067-09 Spruce – 2 balls (A)
- #1067-02 Brick – 2 balls (B)

Premier® Yarns Serenity® Chunky (100% acrylic; 300gm/328 yds)

- #1061-11 Cloud Dancer – 1 ball (C)

Needle: US Size 11 (8 mm) 40" circular needle *or* size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

10 sts x 16 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Stockinette Section:

Odd Rows 1-15: Knit.

Even Rows 2-16: K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

Seed Stitch Section:

Odd Rows 1, 3, 5, 7: K4, *k1, p1*; rep until last 4 sts, k4.

Even Rows 2, 4, 6, 8: K4, *k1, p1*; rep until last 4 sts, k4.

BLANKET

With A, cast on 120 sts.

Knit 4 Rows.

Striping Sequence:

With A, work Stockinette Section.

With C, work Seed Stitch Section.

With B, work Stockinette Section.

With C, work Seed Stitch Section.

Rep Striping Sequence 3 more times (4 in total).

With A, work one more Stockinette Section.

Continuing with A, Knit 4 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

k knit

p purl

rep repeat(ing)

st(s) stitch(es)

St st Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
