

Lexington Pom Pom Hat

Level: Easy



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 19"

MATERIALS

Isaac Mizrahi® CRAFT™ Lexington by Premier®
Yarns (85% acrylic, 15% wool; 140g/69 yds)

- IM2003-08 Stuyvesant – 2 balls

Hook: US M-13 (9 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, large pom pom maker

GAUGE

8 hdc sts x 8 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

PROJECT TIP

For a denser fabric, try working the entire project in single crochet!

HAT

Brim

Ch 7.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each hdc across – 5 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as hdc), hdc in each hdc across.

Rep row 2 until brim measures 19". Sl st last row to first row to join. Turn brim inside out, so that brim seam is on WS of hat.

Body

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as 1 hdc here and through crown), 34 hdc in edge of brim, making approx. 3 hdc per 2 rows of brim. Join with sl st, do not turn. Work even in hdc for 7 more rnds.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: Ch 2, hdc in 2 hdc, hdc2tog, * hdc in 3 hdc, hdc2tog; rep from * to end – 28 hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc, hdc2tog, * hdc in 2 hdc, hdc2tog; rep from * to end – 21 hdc.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc2tog, * hdc in next hdc, hdc2tog; rep from * to end – 14 hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, hdc in next st (counts as first hdc2tog), hdc2tog around – 7 hdc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Gather rem sts and sew side seam.

Weave in ends and lightly block.

Make large pompom and attach pompom to top of hat.

Abbreviations

ch: chain

hdc: half double crochet

hdc2tog: [yarnover, insert hook into next st, yarnover and pull loop through] twice, yarnover, pull through 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: Right Side

sl st: slip stitch

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: Wrong Side
