

Lexington Tweedy Scarf

Level: Easy



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 72"

Width: 7"

MATERIALS

Isaac Mizrahi® CRAFT™ Lexington by Premier® Yarns (85% acrylic, 15% wool; 140g/69 yds)

- IM2003-04 Gramercy Park – 4 balls

Isaac Mizrahi® CRAFT™ Carlyle by Premier® Yarns (77% acrylic, 15% metallic, 8% polyamide; 70g/127 yds)

- IM2008-01 Roosevelt – 1 ball

Hook: US M-13 (9 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, large pom pom maker

GAUGE

12 sts x 7 rows = 4" in patt

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH PATTERN

Spider Stitch (*odd number of sts*)

Row 1: [sc, ch 1, sc] in 3rd ch from hook, * sk 1 ch, [sc, ch1, sc] in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk 1 ch, sc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, sk 2 sc, [sc, ch 1, sc] in each ch-1 sp across, ending sc in 2nd ch of ch-2 sp, turn.

Rep row 2 for patt.

PROJECT TIP

Make your pompoms from Carlyle for a pop of metallic, or purchase extra Lexington and have colors to match!

SCARF

Ch 23.

Work Row 1 of patt across.

Work even in patt until scarf measures 72".

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and lightly block.

Pom Poms

Using pom pom maker, craft 4 – 3” pom poms, being sure to leave a long tail when tying the pompom off, to use to fasten pom pom to scarf.

Sew 1 pom pom to each corner.

Abbreviations

ch: chain

patt: pattern

rep: repeat

sc: single crochet

sk: skip

sp: space

st(s): stitch(es)
