

Blue Lagoon Baby Blanket

By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

36" x 43"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Primo* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100gm/273 yds)

• #28-10 Turquoise – 6 balls

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook or

size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

2 patt rep x 10 rows = 4" in patt Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Rep Rows 2-5 for patt.

Cluster (cl): [Yo, insert hk in st and pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 lps on hk] 5 times, yo and pull through all lps on hk.

Gentle Waves (multiple of 8 ch + 2)

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hk, ch 4, sk 3 ch, * cl in next ch, ch 4, sk 3 ch, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next ch, ch 4, sk 3 ch; rep from * to last 5 ch, cl in next ch, ch 4, sk 3 ch, sc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in 1st sc, ch 2, sc in top of cl, * ch 2, 6 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 2, sc in top of cl; rep from * to last ch-4 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 7 (counts as dc, ch 4), * (sc, ch 1, sc) in next sc, ch 4, sk 3 dc, cl in next dc, ch 4; rep from * to last sc, (sc, ch 1, sc) in last sc, ch 4, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in 1^{st} dc, ch 2, 6 dc in ch-1 sp, * ch 2, dc in top of cl, ch 2, 6 dc in ch-1 sp; rep from * to ch 7 sp, ch 2, sc in 3^{rd} ch of beg ch-7, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, ch 4, * sk 3 dc, cl in next dc, ch 4, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next sc, ch 4; rep from * to last 6-dc shell, sk 3 dc, cl in next dc, ch 4, sc in last sc, turn.

BLANKET

Ch 138.

Row 1 (WS): Work Row 1 of Gentle Waves patt.

Continue in Gentle Waves Patt until Blanket measures approx. 41" ending with Row 2 or 4 of patt.

Border

Work 3 rnds of sc around Blanket, working 3 sc in every corner each rnd. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
