

Samba Shrug

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 18" Length: 35"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Starbella™ (100% acrylic, 100g/33 yds)

• 15-02 Autumn - 5 balls

Needles: US Size 11 (8 mm) and US Size 8 (5 mm)

straight needles

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Gauge is not critical, work evenly throughout project

PATTERN NOTES

When working with the yarn as a ruffle, you will be working in stockinette (knit 1 row, purl 1 row) to keep ruffles on one side of the fabric.

Increase by knitting front and back in one st. Decrease by knitting or purling 2 sts together.

SHRUG

With Size 11 needles, using Starbella™ held closed like a tape yarn, cast on 30 sts.

Row 1: * K2, p2; rep to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: * P2, k2; rep to last 2 sts, p2.

Repeat Rows 1-2 until cuff measures 5" increasing evenly across the last row to 40 sts.

With smaller needles and Starbella™ being worked as a ruffle yarn, working through the holes in the mesh portion of the yarn, work rows of st st until piece measures 30″ from cast on edge, decreasing 10 sts evenly across last row – 30 sts remain.

With larger needles and Starbella[™] held closed like a tape yarn, work Rows 1 and 2 until cuff measures 5". Bind off all sts.

Weave in ends.

k knitp purlrep repeatst, sts stitches

st st stockinette stitch
