

## Sutton Chevron Scarf

Level: Easy



### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 72"

**Width:** 8"

### MATERIALS

Isaac Mizrahi® CRAFT™ Sutton by Premier® Yarns  
(85% acrylic, 15% wool; 113g/68 yds)

- IM2001-08 Columbus – 4 balls

**Hook:** US M-13 (9 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

8 dc x 3½ rows = 4" in patt

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### STITCH PATTERN

#### Chevron

**Row 1:** Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hk, dc in next 3 ch, sk 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, sk 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, 2 dc in last ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Working in back loop across row, ch 3, dc in 1<sup>st</sup> dc, dc in next 3 dc, sk 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, sk 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in t-ch, turn.  
Rep Row 2 for patt.

### PROJECT TIP

Use this same pattern to create an artful throw by sewing scarf lengths together!

### SCARF

Ch 22.

Work Row 1 of patt across.

Work even in patt until scarf measures 72".

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends and lightly block.

### **Fringe**

Cut 60 – 12" lengths of fringe.

Divide fringe into groups of 3.

Place each group along short edge of scarf, arranging 10 groups along each edge.

Trim if necessary.

### **Abbreviations**

**ch:** chain

**dc:** double crochet

**hk:** hook

**patt:** pattern

**rep:** repeat

**sk:** skip
