Sutton Chevron Scarf

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 72" Width: 8"

MATERIALS

Isaac Mizrahi® CRAFT™ *Sutton* by Premier® Yarns (85% acrylic, 15% wool; 113g/68 yds)

• IM2001-08 Columbus – 4 balls

Hook: US M-13 (9 mm) crochet hook *or size*

needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

8 dc x $3\frac{1}{2}$ rows = 4'' in patt **Save time, check your gauge.**

STITCH PATTERN

Chevron

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hk, dc in next 3 ch, sk 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, sk 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, 2 dc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Working in back loop across row, ch 3, dc in 1st dc, dc in next 3 dc, sk 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, sk 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in t-ch, turn.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

PROJECT TIP

Use this same pattern to create an artful throw by sewing scarf lengths together!

SCARF

Ch 22.

Work Row 1 of patt across. Work even in patt until scarf measures 72". Fasten off.

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FINISHING

Weave in ends and lightly block.

Fringe

Cut 60 – 12" lengths of fringe. Divide fringe into groups of 3. Place each group along short edge of scarf, arranging 10 groups along each edge. Trim if necessary.

Abbreviations

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hk: hook patt: pattern rep: repeat sk: skip
