

## West Village Cardigan

Level: Intermediate



### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

#### XS (S, M, L)

**Bust:** 36 (40, 42, 48)''

#### MATERIALS

Isaac Mizrahi® CRAFT™ *West Village* by Premier® Yarns (39% cotton, 39% acrylic, 17% glitter, 5% payette ; 70gm/191 yds)

- IM2009-05 Sheridan Square  
– 6 (6, 7, 7) skeins

**Hook:** US Size H (5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, 1'' button, stitch markers

#### GAUGE

12 dc x 7 rows = 4'' in pattern

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### STITCH GUIDE

**Paired Double Crochet Stitch** (*multiple of 2 sts +4*)

**Foundation Row:** Dc in 3rd ch from hk and in each ch to end.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), \* dc2tog over next 2 dc, ch 1; rep from \* to end, dc in last st.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc2tog over first 2 ch-1 sps,\* dc2tog over last ch-1 sp and next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from\* to end, working second leg of last dc2tog in top of turning ch, then ch 1, dc in top of turning ch.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

**PATTERN NOTE:** Place a marker to indicate neck edge as opposed to armhole edge to avoid confusion when reversing shaping for right front.

### SWEATER

#### Back

Ch 56 (62, 68, 74).

Beg with Foundation row, work Paired Double Crochet St for 13 (13½, 14, 14½)'', ending with a WS row.

## Armhole

**Next Row (RS):** Sl st in at beg of row for 2 (2½, 3, 3½)", cont in patt across row, stopping 2 (2½, 3, 3½)" in from end of row.

Cont in patt until armhole meas 7 (7½, 8, 8½)".

Fasten off.

## Left Front

Ch 40 (46, 52, 58)

Beg with Foundation row, work Paired Double Crochet St for 12(12½, 13, 13½)", ending with a WS row.

## Shape Neck

**Dec Row (RS):** Work in patt to last 2 dc, turn.

**Dec Row (WS):** Sl st in first 2 dc, work in patt to end.

Rep last 2 rows, dec'ing at neck edge, until Front measures the same length as back.

At the same time, when piece meas 13 (13½, 14, 14½)" work armhole dec at beg of RS row as follows: sl st in 2 (2½, 3, 3½)" from edge, work in patt across.

When Front measures the same as Back, Fasten off.

## Right Front

Work the same as left front reversing shaping.

## Sleeves (make 2)

Ch 46 (52, 58, 64).

Work Foundation row & Row 1 of patt.

**Inc Row:** Ch 3, dc, ch 1, dc in first ch-1 sp, work in patt to last ch 1-sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last ch-1 sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in top of turning ch.

Cont in patt, rep Inc Row every 3rd row until sleeve meas 5 (5½, 6, 6½)" long.

Work in patt for 2 (2½, 3, 3½)" more without increasing. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew fronts to back at shoulder seams.

Sew in the sleeves to body.

Sew side and sleeve seams.

Beg at the bottom of the right front, work 2 rows of sc around the entire edge of the sweater. On the second round, make a chain 6 button loop at the base of the V split on the right front.

Sew a 1" button on the other side of the V of the left front.

Weave in ends.

**beg:** beginning

**ch:** chain

**cont:** continue

**dc:** double crochet

**dc2tog:** double crochet 2sts together

**dec:** decrease

**hk:** hook

**meas:** measures

**patt:** pattern

**RS:** right side

**rep:** repeat

**sc:** single crochet

**sk:** skip

**sl st:** slip stitch

**sp:** space

**st(s):** stitch (es)

**WS:** wrong side
