



ASSEMBLY STEPS


















Wood Installation:

Hold Ceiling Plate (I) up to desired mounting location making sure one of the long edges is making contact with the back support wall. Secure Ceiling Plate (I) using ST5.5x16mm Screws (W-A) and a drill.




Concrete/Brick Installation:

Hold Ceiling Plate (I) up to desired mounting location making sure one of the long edges is making contact with the back support wall. Mark hole locations using a pencil or marker. Drill 1.8" (45mm) deep holes using a 5/16" (8mm) drill bit. Insert Concrete Anchors (W-C) and install Ceiling Plate (I) using ST5.5x38mm Screws (W-B) and a Phillips screwdriver.





Align the holes from Lift Column (A) and Ceiling Plate (I). Insert Clevis Pin (S-A) through the motor and Ceiling Plate (I). Insert Cotter Pin (S-B) into Clevis Pin (S-A) to secure.





Concrete/Brick Installation:

Mark Wall Mounting Plate (A1) hole locations using a pencil or marker. Remove Lift Column (A) from Ceiling Plate (I) or hold away from the wall. Drill 1.8"/45mm deep holes using a 5/16"/8mm drill bit. Insert Concrete Anchors (W-C) and install Lift Column (A) using ST5.5x38mm Screws (W-B) and a Phillips screwdriver.










RF Remote - Manual

PAIRING THE REMOTE:

Step 1: Double press the (B) button on Control Unit (F). The status light on the control unit will turn on indicating you have entered programming mode.

Step 2: Press and hold the ** + *(ox) buttons simultaneously on the remote until the status light stops flashing. When the status light is turned off, that indicates a successful pairing.

RF REMOTE - Button Functions:





UP ARROW:

Moves the mount upwards/retracts mount towards the motor. Press and hold to raise your TV.



DOWN ARROW:


Moves the mount downwards/ extends mount away from the motor. Press and hold to lower your TV.



OK BUTTON:

Fully retracts the mount/moves to highest position.

CONTROL UNIT- Button Functions





PROGRAM BUTTON:

Double press to turn on status light and enter programming mode.



MANUAL RETRACT:

Press and hold to retract the mount towards the motor.

TROUBLESHOOTING

The Mount Does Not Respond to Remote Control

Solutions - TV Mount

- 1. Disconnected Cord: A cord may be loose or no longer connected. Check all power connections and proceed.
- 2. Incorrect Operation: Please refer to "RF Remote" for proper functions of remote.

Solutions - Remote Control

- 1. Operating Distatance: The remote may be too far away from the mount and out of proper range. Move closer to the mount so that you are within the 30 ft (10m) range of remote.
- 2. Low Batteries: Batteries may be low or dead. Replacement batteries and attempt use again.
- 3. Program Coding Error: The remote may not have been properly coded. Please follow "Pairing the Remote" steps again.
- 4. Faulty Remote or Control Box: If mount is still unresponsive, the remote or control unit may be faulty. Please contact our Product Support Team at 309-278-5303 or help@vivo-us.com.
