


## - Option 1 - Wood Joist Mounting

## **Assembly Steps**


## STEP 1

Attach Mount Extensions (**D**) to the top of Mount (**A**) with M6x8mm Screws (**S-B**) using 4mm Allen Wrench (**T-B**).



#### STEP 2

Mark mounting location as shown using studfinder, Template (C), and pencil.







#### **Flush to Wall Installation**

If you are installing the Mount Assembly with the bottom of the TV against a wall in the up position, it is recommended to leave a 3"(25.4mm) gap between the TV and the wall.


Drill mounting holes at marked locations using infographic below.



For the pilot hole(s) that align with the keyhole slot(s) on the mount, insert ST6.3x55mm Screw (W-A), leaving a 5mm gap from the ceiling.




Hang Mount (A) so the screw heads are through the keyhole opening(s) and turn until the mount is support by the screw(s). Secure Mount using the remaining ST6.3x55mm Screws (W-A), M6 Washers (W-C), and a Phillips screwdriver.




## - Option 2 - Solid Wood Mounting

## STEP 1


Using Template (C), mark the inner 6 holes as shown.



Drill mounting holes at marked locations using infographic below.



For the pilot holes that align with a keyhole slot on the mount, insert a ST6.3x55mm Screw **(W-A)**, leaving a 5mm gap from the ceiling.







#### Flush to Wall Installation







## **Concrete Mounting**

#### STEP 1


Using Template (C), mark the inner 6 holes as shown.



Drill mounting holes at marked locations using infographic below.



Insert Concrete Anchors (**W-B**) into holes. For the Concrete Anchors that align with a keyhole slots on the mount, insert a ST6.3x55mm Screw (**W-A**), leaving a 5mm gap from the ceiling.







#### Flush to Wall Installation


If you are installing the Mount Assembly with the bottom of the TV against a wall in the up position, it is recommended to leave a 3"(25.4mm) gap between the TV and the wall.







Attach Bracket Rails (F) to Center Plate (B) using M6 Nuts (S-C) and a wrench. Insert End Caps (J) into the ends of Bracket Rails.




Slide VESA Brackets **(E)** onto Bracket Rails **(F)**. Attach M4x8mm Screws **(S-D)** to the ends of Bracket Rails using 3mm Allen Wrench **(T-A)**.




Slide VESA Brackets (E) to match your TVs VESA pattern.




Insert Set Screws (S-A) into the ends of VESA Brackets (E) to lock them in place. Tighten using 3mm Allen Wrench (T-A). Loosen the top two Preinstalled Screws (B1) on Center Plate (B) until 5mm of threading is exposed. Remove the remaining 3 preinstalled screws (B2) and set aside for later.




Attach VESA assembly to TV using appropriate mounting screws (M-A through M-D), M8 Washers (M-E), and Spacers (M-F, M-G).




Place the TV with VESA bracket assembly onto Mount (A) by lining up top 2 loosened Screws (B1) and inserting into keyholes at desired height. Tighten Screws.




Secure Mount (A) using previously removed Screws (B2) and tighten with a Phillips screwdriver.






Run cables along mount and use Cable Ties (I) to secure in place. NOTE: Leave some slack in cables to allow for arm movement.

Plug AC Adapter **(G)** into Mount **(A)**, and connect to an AC outlet. Use the Remote **(H)** manual for operating instruction. If Remote is not paired, follow the "Pairing the Remote" instructions on Page 22 to pair the Remote to the Mount.





Be sure to plug the AC Adapter **(G)** into a power outlet AFTER connecting it to the Mount. Connecting the Adapter in the wrong order may cause a large spark.



## Mount Installed On Angled/Sloped Ceiling?

#### \*\* PLEASE FOLLOW PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS BELOW \*\*

FAILURE TO PROPERLY PROGRAM THE MOUNT PRIOR TO USE ON A SLOPED, PITCHED, OR ANGLED CEILING MAY RESULT IN DAMAGE TO THE INTERNAL MOTOR CAUSING THE MOUNT TO FAIL AND REMAIN STUCK IN THE UP POSITION.

## Retract Mount to Upright Position

Press and hold the OK button on the Remote (H) for 6 seconds. The mount will retract upward to it's folded position against the ceiling.

#### **BELT TENSION APPEAR LOOSE?**

If the belt tension is loose (fig. 2) firmly grasp both Inner Belts before proceeding to establish tension (fig. 3). Proceed with retracting mount and release Inner Belt when tension is tight (fig. 1)


## 2 Lower Mount


Short press and release the down button begin lowering the TV. Short press OK when the TV has reached the lowest position and has a secure tension (fig 1).

If the belt is loose (fig. 2), the mount was NOT stopped soon enough. Firmly grasp both Inner Belts (fig. 3) to establish tension, then short press and release the up arrow to begin raising the mount. Short press the OK button when tension is secure (fig.1).

## 3 Set Maximum Lowered Position

Press and hold the mount beeps. **Repeat 4 times.** After the 4th time, the mount will give a long beep, indicating that the lowest angle has been set. The mount is now ready for use.



## **Remote Control Manual**



## First Time Use

- 1. Install two AAA batteries (not included) in the Remote.
- 2. Plug the mount in. The mount will beep once, and will be ready for operation.
- 3. Press the  $\triangle$  button to move the TV upward toward the ceiling. Press the 6 button to stop the motion.
- 4. Press the  $\nabla$  button to move the TV downwards toward the lowest position (75° angle). Press the  $\bigcirc$  button to stop the motion.

#### **Functions and Features**

#### **Save & Recall Memory Settings**

To save a certain location to memory, press and hold the mem1 or mem2 button for 1 seconds. The mount will beep, indicating the position has been saved to memory.

To recall memory locations, press  $\begin{pmatrix} 1 & \text{or } & 2 \end{pmatrix}$  and the TV mount will automatically adjust to saved memory location of the corresponding memory button.

#### Reset

Unplug the power for 10 seconds, then re-plug the power. Press the 🕟 button for 6 seconds. The Mount will retract to the highest position, indicating that the system has been successfully reset.

#### **Pairing the Remote**

**Step 1:** With the Mount powered on, quick press the small button on the left side of the Mount with a thin tool (such as a paperclip) as shown. The unit will beep, indicating readiness for pairing.

**Step 2:** *Immediately* quick press the (set) button on the Remote (you have 3 seconds to complete this after pressing the button on the Mount).

The Mount will beep repeatedly for 10 seconds, indicating that the Remote is being programmed to the Mount. When the beeping has stopped, the Mount will be ready for operation.

**Note:** The Mount can be paired with up to 20 Remotes.

**Folded Mount Pairing:** If the Remote needs to be paired while the Mount is folded, the small button may be partially obscured. Angle your thin tool to reach the button.



## **Unpairing the Remote**

Press and hold the small button on the control box with a thin tool until two beeps are heard. The two beeps indicates that the Mount is successfully unpaired from all Remotes and the App.

#### Functions and Features - Cont'd

#### **Pairing Remote to Multiple Units**

The included Remote may be paired to multiple units, allowing all installed Mounts to be controlled simultaneously. Follow the steps outlined in "Pairing the Remote" on Page 22 for each Mount to pair to a single Remote.


To change each unit back to using individual Remotes, first unpair the Mounts from the Remote following the "Unpairing the Remote" instructions on Page 22. Then repeat the pairing steps using the individual Remotes for each Mount.



The Mount is Making a Buzzing Alarm Sound	This signals an error in Mount position. Reset the system by following the "Reset" instructions on page 22.	
Remote Battery Drains Too Quickly	Make sure that your Remote has fresh batteries. If problem persists with fresh batteries, please contact us at 309-278-5303 or help@vivo-us.com to replace the Remote.	
Remote Buttons Don't Work	Check to make sure the Remote has working batteries. If the problem persists, try to re-pair the Remote following the "Pairing the Remote" instructions on page 22. If the problem persists, please contact us at 309-278-5303 or help@vivo-us.com to replace the Remote. If the problem persists with the replacement Remote, contact us to replace the product.	
Remote Has Limited Range	If your Remote has a limited range and won't function unless it is within 10 feet (3 meters) of the Mount, replace the batteries. If the problem persists, please contact us at 309-278-5303 or help@vivo-us.com to replace the Remote.











## **Tuya App | Basic Functions**





## Standard Operation

#### **Using Arrow Keys**

**UP:** Tap the  $\triangle$  button to move the TV upward toward the ceiling. Press the 68 button to stop the motion.


**DOWN:** Tap the  $\nabla$  button to move the TV downwards toward the lowest position. Press the  $\bigcirc$  button to stop the motion.

## **Saving & Using Memory Settings**

Use the arrow buttons to set your desired TV position. Then select one of the 3 Memory Buttons to save the position as a preset. To return to a preset, simply select the ② icon next to the desired Memory setting. For example, to return to Memory Setting 2, select the ③ icon next to ].


Please note: Tuya Smart app has three memory functions, while the standard remote has only two.

## Setting Up & Creating an Account



#### **TURN ON WIFI**

Before you begin, ensure that Wifi is enabled on your phone.



#### **CREATE ACCOUNT**


Open Tuya Smart App and select **Sign-Up** from start screen. Follow on-screen prompts.

## Pairing to Mount



#### **ADD DEVICE**

Tap **Add Device** or the **+** icon in upper right corner to begin device pairing.



#### **MOTORIZED TV SOLUTION**

Tap *Motorized TV Solution* in the Auto Scan page and go to "Next".

Only one Tuya Smart account can be synced to Mount at one time.

If Mount does not appear, refer to "Unpairing Mount from App (option 2)"

## Pairing to Mount - Cont'd



#### **CONNECT TO WIFI**

Select your Wifi from available list and enter password to enable mount access. Tap "Next".



#### **CONNECTION SCREEN**

If Wifi connection was successful, connection to your TV mount will begin. Please allow 10-60 seconds for connection process to be completed.




#### **DEVICE ADDED SUCCESSFULLY**

Once connection is made, a confirmation screen will show. Click "Done" to enter the Remote Dashboard.

**Note:** From here, you can tap the ∠ icon to change the name of your TV mount, if desired.

Turn to Page 27 for operation instructions.

## **Unpairing Mount from App**



From the Home screen, locate your TV mount, then long press to open device options.

**Option 1:** Select **Remove Device** at the bottom of the screen to unpair the mount from your app.

**Option 2:** Long press the (SET) button on the Remote for 5 seconds. A beep is emitted signaling the Mount is disconnected from the app.

## Reset Mount with App

#### **RESET MODE**

If the Mount operates abnormally, it may be necessary to perform a reset of the Mount.

To reset, unplug the mount from power for 10 seconds and plug back in. Press and hold the observation for 6 seconds. The Mount will go up to it's highest position and the control box will emit 2 short beeps, indicating that the process is complete.

## Syncing Other Mobile Devices

To allow other mobile devices to control the TV mount, you will need to first create **Home** in the app and then invite other users to your Home.



#### **HOME MANGEMENT**

Select the **ME** (**①**) icon to navigate to the Home screen. Tap **Home Management**.



#### **SET UP HOME**

Complete required information to set up a HOME and tap **SAVE** to continue.

Please note: The **Home Name** has a 25 character limit.



#### **CREATE A HOME**

Tap Create A Home to proceed.



#### **HOME**

Return to Home Management screen and tap the **Home** you just created.

## Syncing Other Mobile Devices - Cont'd



#### **INVITE OTHER MEMBERS**

Tap **Add Member** and choose an invitation method. New users will receive link to download Tuya Smart app with an invitation code to join your **Home.** Users will need to download app and create an account to procced.



#### **ENTER INVITATION CODE**

Enter the code that was received with the invitation and tap • to continue.



#### **JOINING A HOME**

Once app is installed and registered, new user will tap the **ME** ( ( ) icon on the bottom right. From that screen, tap **Home Management** and then **Join a Home.** 



#### **HOME ADDED**

The new **Home** will now show under **Home Management**.

## Syncing Other Mobile Devices - Cont'd



#### **CHANGING HOME SCREEN**

Select the  $\widehat{\omega}$  icon to navigate to the Home screen. Tap the  $\bigvee$  next to My Home... at the top of the screen.



#### **DEVICE ADDED**

New home screen will now show mount. Click on mount name to activate controls.



#### **SELECT NEW HOME**

From dropdown, select the name of the new home you were invited to.

Please note: You may be asked to allow Wifi permissions.

## Setting Up Amazon Alexa



#### **DOWNLOAD AMAZON ALEXA APP**

Download the Amazon Alexa app from the App Store or Google Play. Once installed, return to the Tuya app and tap on "me" in the bottom right corner, and tap "Alexa".



#### LINK

Tap "Link" to begin the linking process.



#### SIGN IN

Click "Sign in with Amazon".



#### **DEVICE ADDED**

Once the linking is complete, you can start controlling the TV mount via Amazon Alexa.

## Setting Up Google Home



#### **DOWNLOAD GOOGLE HOME APP**

Download the Google Home app from the App Store or Google Play. Once installed, return to the Tuya app and tap on "me" in the bottom right corner, and tap on "Google Assistant".



#### **CONTINUE**

Tap "Continue" to return to the Tuya App.



#### LINK

Tap "Link with Google Assistant" to launch the Google Home app.



#### **DEVICE ADDED**

Tap "Agree and link" to return to the Google Home app. The linking is complete, and you can start controlling the TV mount via Google Home.


