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# Best art for your earlobes

Talk about drawing art from life. Warren artist **Leeann Herreid's jewelry** incorporates the overlooked aesthetic features of common objects you're more likely to find in a hardware store than dangling from earlobes. Yes, take her earrings, for example. The red lines of functioning thermometers (\$38) draw attention on one pair; the greenish liquid of bubble level components do so on another (\$68). Where Herreid more subtly helps us appreciate overlooked objects is with her stud earrings: Phillips head or slot, your choice of sterling silver screw heads (\$29). The tiny plumb bob necklace (\$156) might be the most spot-on combo of form and function, but the coolest offering is the multi-carat diamond necklace for \$180. Yup.
