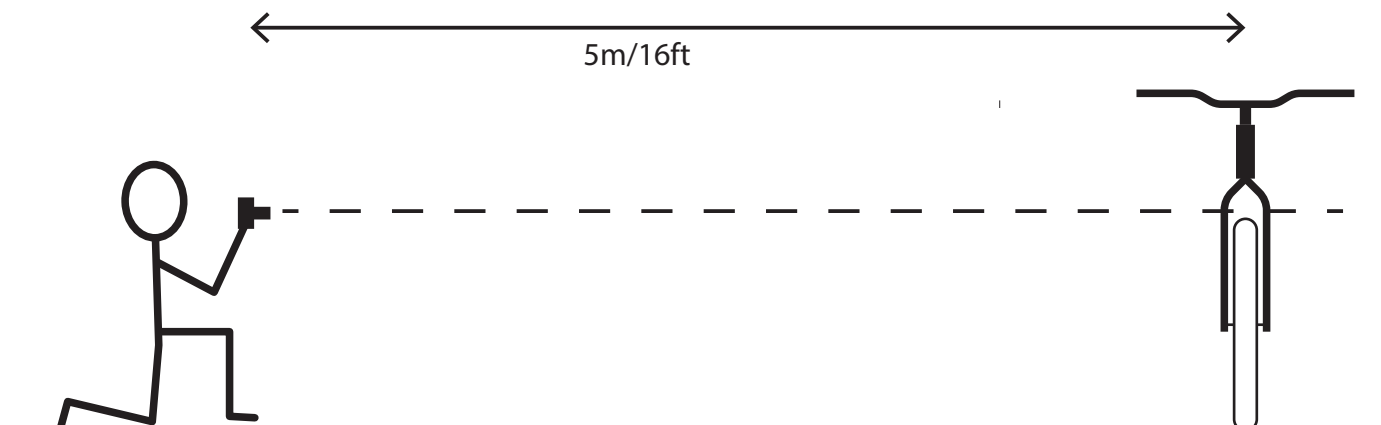


# Photo Templates

To make a frame bag from a photo of your bike I need a quality image taken from the right position. Below are a few steps to ensure you get the right photo.

- If you are wanting a full frame bag then take all bottle cages off the frame and place the bolts back in the holes. If you are getting a half frame bag then make sure you have any cages and bottles installed so I can make the bag to fit around them.
- Attach a ruler, tape measure or an item of a known measurement to the frame, ideally something longer than 300mm. When you attach it to the frame ensure it does not obstruct the view of the inside of the frame, along the top tube is ideal.
- Place your bike up against a contrasting background so the edges of the frame are easy to identify in the photo. Ensure the bike is as close to vertical as possible.
- Walk 5m back from the frame (more if you are using a high resolution camera such as a DSLR) and crouch down so the camera will be in the same horizontal plane as the centre of the frame. The camera must be more than 5m away from the bike. You can zoom in but don't zoom in too much if you are using a phone as quality will start to reduce.



- Take your photo and review it to ensure you can read the markings on the ruler or your item of known measurement. I need ONE photo that is taken from more than 5m away from the bike where the markings are legible.
