



Creating Frames

Containers for text, symbols and images

Frames are containers that can be placed anywhere on a page, they can contain:

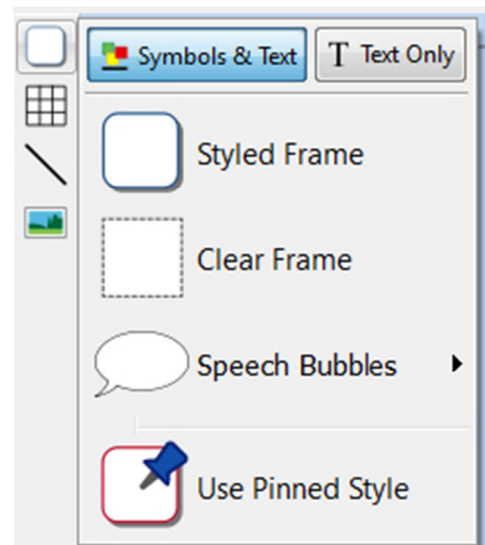
- **Symbol & Text** content
- **Text Only** Content
- **Images**

Frames can be clear, so their content appears without a border or background, or they can be styled in a number of ways. You can also create 'Speech Bubble' frames.

1. To create a frame, click the **Frame** button on the Create toolbar on the left of the screen.

From the **Frame** menu that appears, you can:

- Choose the content mode of your frame from **Symbols & Text** or **Text Only**
- Choose to create a styled frame, clear frame or speech bubble
- Choose to create a frame using a pinned style



2. After making your selection, the frame will be stuck to your cursor allowing you to move it around the page.

Click on the page to place the frame in your preferred location.



Tip: The **Frame** tab appears on the top toolbar when a frame is selected. This tab can be used to edit the appearance and settings of your frame.
