

### Quickstart Guide Responsable Switch-Adapted Emergency Wall Communicator (EWC)




### **Installing Batteries**



- 1. Unscrew battery cover from EWC and insert batteries as shown.
- 2. Replace battery cover.
- 3. Plug any AbleNet switch into jack on front of device
  - This switch can now be used for the same functions as the Red "Help" button.

## Pairing EWC with Base Unit



- 1. Press and Release Red "Code Learn" button on back of Responsable Base Unit.
  - Device will speak, "Pendant Learning"
- 2. Press and Hold Gray then Red buttons on EWC until you hear, "Pendant Learning." Release buttons.
- 3. When successfully paired, device will speak, "All systems are OK" then announce current dialing mode.

Notes: If Code Learning fails, wait 30 seconds, then retry by starting the process over.

# **Basic Use**



- 1. To call out, Press and Hold the switch for 2 seconds.
  - Responsable will dial the emergency number(s) based on the calling mode selected. (See Responsable System Manual for modes.)
- 2. To hang up, Press and Release the Gray button one time.
  - The other caller can also end the call by pressing 9 on their keypad (preferred) or by simply hanging up.
- 3. To answer an incoming call, Press and Release the switch one time.

## **Battery and Systems Check**



**To test battery status** - Press and Release the device's Gray button. The device will speak its current battery condition.

**To test system status** - Press and Hold the device's Gray button for 4 seconds. The device will speak the current system conditions.

Note: See Responsable System Manual for status details.

# Mounting, Warranty and Contact

### Mounting the EWC

EWC can be mounted using screws or hook and loop fastener included.

- Position screws exactly 3½-inches apart.
- Velcro® should be adhered to a clean and dry surface.
- Use AbleNet's Small Rectangular Mounting Plate and mounting systems for wheelchair or bed rail mounting.

#### Warranty
