

READY ROCKS™



INSTRUCTIONS FOR C1136-C1140, C1142

NOTE: Shelf (C1136) and Rock Face (C1138) Ready Rocks fit together in a top-to-bottom and side-to-side interlocking pattern (**Fig. 1 and 2**). Pattern can be repeated over and over to create an endless rock wall. They can also be arranged individually.

1. Test-fit Ready Rocks in desired locations.
2. Attach with Lightweight Hydrocal®* Plaster (C1201), Shaper Sheet™ Plaster (C1180), wadded Plaster Cloth (C1191-C1193, C1203) or Foam Tack Glue™ (ST1444).
3. If using a plaster product to attach, soak Ready Rocks in water for 10 seconds and brush terrain with water where Rocks will be attached.
4. Apply adhesive onto backside of Ready Rock and hold in place on layout until setting begins. Try to keep adhesive off the rock face or it will lose some of its rock-like detail.
5. Fill gaps with one of the above listed plaster products.
6. Ready Rocks were colored with Earth Colors™ Liquid Pigment and the Leopard Spot Paint Technique, using Yellow Ocher (C1223), Burnt Umber (C1222), Raw Umber (C1221) and highlighted with a Black wash (C1220). Visit woodlandscenics.com for How-to Videos on coloring rocks.

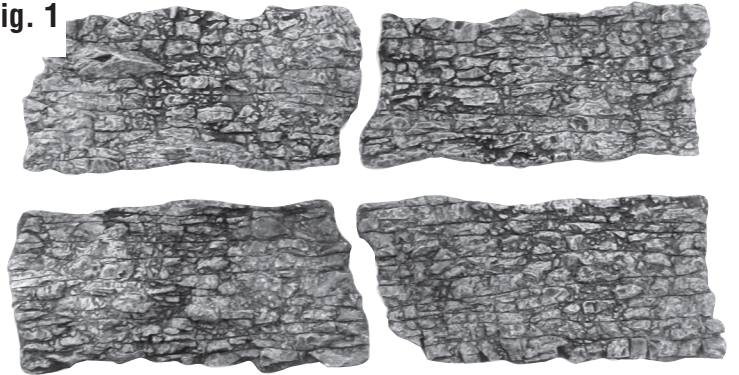
