# Traffic Light 1.0 (TL-1)

## Instructions

## **Getting Started**

Thank you for purchasing an E.C.C. electronic device. Please take a moment to read and familiarize with the following instructions prior to installing this circuit. The Traffic Light 1.0 (TL-1) simulates the typical behavior of your typical traffic light.

The Traffic Light 1.0 (**TL-1**) operates as described next. Terminals R, Y, G and C illustrate the wires connections (Red, Yellow, Green and Common or Positive). Resistors are provided for use with various traffic lights readily available.

You should make all connections to the circuit prior to applying power. You can mount this circuit anywhere. We suggest mounting the circuit under the layout. The circuit is equipped with holes for easy mounting; do not enlarge holes as doing so can cause damage to the circuit and will void your warranty.




Figure 1- (Wiring)



### **Multiple Traffic Lights**

The **TL-1** is able to handle 4 single lane traffic lights, 2 double sided and 2 four sided Walther Cornerstone Series traffic lights.

#### **Additional Feature**

This circuit is equipped with a night time operation sequence or caution and stop which consist of having the yellow and red lights flash, this sequence is usually used at night for intersections with low traffic volume. The road with minor movement (less traffic) gets the Red flashing light and the road with the major movement (more traffic) gets the yellow flashing light. For this feature to be triggered the jumper wire between pads SW3 and SW2 has to removed and replaced with an ON-ON toggle as show in Figure 2.



#### **Power**

The **TL-1** accepts AC or DC power (9V- 12V), **100mA Max.** This circuit is designed to operate under any straight DC or AC current provided the voltage doesn't exceed **12V**, **100mA**. If you are using a power pack transformer we strongly recommend using the fixed AC output terminals. Not doing so will cause the circuit to overheat and fail, which will void the warranty.


## Warranty
