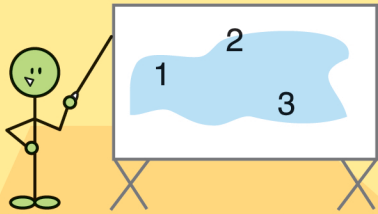
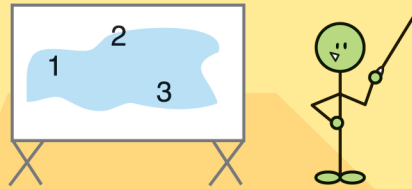


A chord scale is like a map.



The numbers help musicians understand the big picture of what they are playing,



and helps them talk to each other about it!



THE CHORD SCALE MAP

Roman numerals say which step of the scale you are on.

Major chords are capitalized and minor chords are lower case.

Diminished chords sound strange because the fifth is lowered.

I	C	MAJOR	
ii	D	MINOR	
iii	E	MINOR	
IV	F	MAJOR	
V	G	MAJOR	
vi	A	MINOR	
vii^o	B	DIMINISHED	
I	C	MAJOR	

I get it!
In the C chord scale, F is the four chord!
