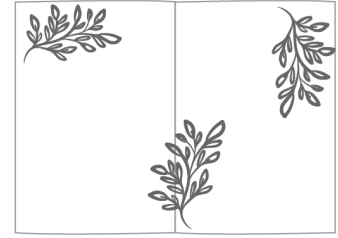
DRAW A SINGLE KINDA SWOOPY LINE:

swatches

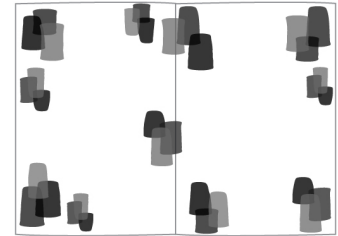
USE A ROUND OR FLAT BRUSH TO CREATE A SINGLE BRUSH STROKE:

START WITH A SINGLE SWOOPY LINE:



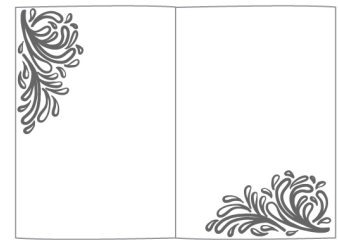
ADD A FEW SWOOPS TO BUILD OFF OF YOUR FIRST SWOOP:

flowers

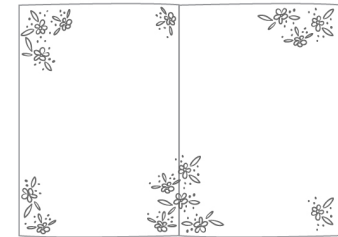
START WITH A GROUP OF 3 MINI FLOWERS:

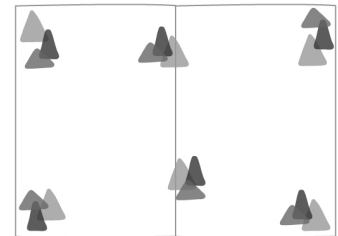
START WITH A BASIC SHAPE:
