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# Furniture and Carpet Indentations

For a thorough cleaning of your upholstered furniture and carpet areas, a professional steam clean is the way to go.



*Tip:*  
Melt an ice cube on flattened carpet fibres and use a fork to spruce them back up!



## Bleach

Leaves your bathroom sparkling! Fill a water spray bottle with a combination of half bleach and half water and spray on mould in grouting. Leave this for 10 minutes then lightly scrub, repeat these steps if necessary to remove remaining mould. This can also be performed to remove stains in sink. Place the plug in sink, with enough bleach to cover the surface. Leave this for 10 minutes then remove the plug to wash away bleach.

# Cleaning Vinegar

Different to regular vinegar, cleaning vinegar can be utilised to clean all household surfaces, including your windows! To get the best, streak-free results, be sure to wipe down with a newspaper.

*Tip:*

For stubborn carpet stains, make a paste with 2TbIs white distilled vinegar and 1/4 cup baking soda. Rub into stain and leave it overnight. Vacuum residue the next day!



# Peppermint Oil

Dissolves tacky marks left after peeling off stickers from walls, doors or furnishings. Begin with gently wetting the sticker with water, then slowly try to peel off. Finish by patting with peppermint oil until the remaining sticker has fallen off.

Additionally, peppermint oil prevents cockroaches and can be used on the cloth of your steam mop to give your floors a fresh look and smell!



# Artwork Holes



Holes left from small picture hooks can look unappealing to potential buyers. In order to make them less noticeable, apply a small amount of toothpaste with your finger or other small utensil such as the top of a knife. This will fill the gap and harden without the mess of plaster dust.
