


Diagram of the Seven Covenants of the Bible


The Central Focus: Covenant

- What is a covenant?
 - The extension of kinship by oath
- Why should we think "covenant" important?
 - The Bible is divided into two covenants
 - The Liturgy says: "again and again you offered a covenant to man," or now, "time and again you offered them covenants"
 - The Eucharist is "the new and eternal covenant"
 - This implies old and temporary ones that preceded it

More on Covenants


- Why does God deal with us through covenants?
 - Because he wants to make us his family, though we are not by nature
- Understanding the Bible depends on grasping the sequence of covenants

These are the privileges of the covenant:




- 1. Son: Gen 1:26; 5:3 "image" and "likeness"
- 2. King: Gen 1:26 "dominion"
- 3. Priest: Gen 2:15 "work" and "guard"
- 4. Prophet: Gen 2:19-20
- 5. Bridegroom: Gen 2:23-25


These roles for us: CCC §901-908




The Noahic Covenant

The Abrahamic Covenant

- A different approach than the flood
 - God will work with one man's family to restore blessing to all the world

A Triple Blessing Begins Abraham's Journey: "2 And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you... and by you all the families of the earth shall bless themselves." —Gen 12:2-3


Promise




I have sworn... because you have not withheld your only begotten son, I will surely bless you...

And by your seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed"



The Mosaic Covenant




What Happened?

Fall! The Golden Calf (Exod 32)


- Covenant Renewed (Ex 34), but More Laws (Leviticus!)




The King is Son of God 2 Sam 7:14


The King will build the Temple: 2 Sam 7:13


The King will rule the whole world: Ps. 2:8; 89:25-27

What Happened to the Davidic Covenant?











The New Covenant in the Prophets








The Eucharistic Covenant

- Jesus Comes to Fulfill all the covenants
 - Matt. 1:1: "The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham."
 - Gen 5:1: "The book of the genealogy of Adam ..."
 - The son of David, not a son of David
 - The son of Abraham, not a son of Abraham
 - Jesus a new Moses: bread from heaven, etc.
 - Jesus a new David by his exorcisms, etc.




Diagram of the Seven Covenants of the Bible


