WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN CLASSIC AND VOLUME?

Classic Lashing is the art of applying 1 extension to 1 natural lash, whereas Volume Lashing is multiple lashes on 1 natural lash.

Each style of lashing creates a different look on your client. Classic lashing is used to create a more natural look, whereas Volume lashing creates a fuller, fluffier look.

DO I NEED TO DO CLASSIC BEFORE VOLUME?

If you are a beginner in the world of lash extensions, you will need to complete Classic training before moving onto a Volume course.

The Classic Course will not only teach you how to create a Classic set, it teaches you how to apply lash extensions, the science behind the glue, how to correctly and efficiently isolate lashes and all of the base knowledge of lashing that is needed to move onto further techniques.

You are able to do your Classic and Volume course together in one weekend if the dates set in your location allow!

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO GET CERTIFIED?

This will depend how often you are lashing and submitting your models to your trainer - as well as if you are taking their feedback on board for your sets!

On average, students receive certification after the submission of between 3-8 models.
