### Bridal Bouquet

- 7-9 Pink Mondial Roses
- 5-6 White Ranunculus
- 3-4 White Carnations
- 3-5 Cream Spray Roses
- 4-5 White Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Parvifolia Euc, Baby Euc, Leatherleaf Fern and Israeli Ruscus



## Bridesmaid Bouquet

- 5 Pink Mondial Roses
- 2 White Ranunculus
- 2-3 White Carnations
- 1 Cream Spray Rose
- 2 White Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Parvifolia Euc, Baby Euc, Leatherleaf Fern and Israeli Ruscus



### Bouts & Corsages

I average 1-2 Spray Rose or Mini Carnation buds per bout, and 3 buds per corsage. Add sprigs of your favorite green! I like to save a Ranunculus for the groom's bout to make his special!

### 2 Large Ceremony Urns or 2 Large Foam Cages for Arch

#### Perurn/cage:

- 13 Pink Mondial Roses
- 13 White Carnations
- 1 bunch of Baby Eucalyptus
- 1 bunch of Silver Dollar Eucalyptus
- 1 bunch of Leatherleaf Fern



# 10 Centerpieces with 5-6" Vase Diameter

- 5-6 Pink Mondial Roses
- 2-3 White Carnations
- 2 Cream Spray Roses
- 2-3 Light Pink Mini Carnations
- 2-3 White Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Parvifolia Euc, Baby Euc and Leatherleaf Fern

# Recipes for Blush and Cream Packages



## 25-30 Mason Jars -or-3-4" Vase Diameter

- 2 Pink Mondial Roses
- 1 White Carnation
- 0-1 Cream Spray Rose
- 1 Light Pink Mini Carnation
- 1 White Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Parvifolia Euc, Baby Euc, and Leatherleaf Fern



### 50-60 Bud Vases

Each one will look different. Average 2-3 blooms per bud vase and a sprig of greenery. These are the flowers allotted for the bud vases:

- 50 Pink Mondial Roses
- 25 White Carnations
- 20 Cream Spray Roses
- 30 White Lisianthus
- 20 Light Pink Mini Carnations
- 2 bunches of Parvifolia Eucalyptus
- 2 bunches of Baby Eucalyptus
- 2 bunches of Leatherleaf Fern

## Special Care Notes

## Special Flower Care Notes for Items Specific to this Package

- Roses and Lisianthus: Reflexing your roses and lisianthus is a baller florist
  move! Not only does it create visual interest, it makes your product
  larger, getting you more bang for your buck! I do this right before I pull
  the flower into a design.
- **Ranunculus**: Have 22 gauge straight floral wire on hand in case they are heavily curved and bending under their own weight. We have a Youtube video on how to do this!
- Carnations: Sometimes these guys can come in closed, but with carnations, you can easily use thumbs to push or 'mash' them open. They are extremely tough and hardy, and the only flower you can manhandle in that way.
- **Gunni Eucalyptus:** The tops of this greenery can have young, tender leaves. Sometimes the tops will wilt and curl. This is normal and should be snipped or pinched off. The bunch is not bad when this occurs, it's just fresh, tender growth!
- **Bug Nibbles**: Remember that you are working with unprocessed greenery, so you may find some leaves that have been munched. Just snip those away! Nibbles are typically found on seeded euc and salal.
