Bridal Bouquet

- 4-5 Free Spirit Roses
- 4-5 Pink Floyd Roses
- 2-3 Yellow Solidago
- 2-3 Yellow Button Poms
- Sprigs of Thistle
- 3-4 Peach Carnations
- 3-4 Raspberry Scabiosa
- 3-4 Orange Ranunculus
- Sprigs of Pennycress, Variegated Pittosporum, and Israeli Ruscus.

Bridesmaid Bouquet

- 2 Free Spirit Roses
- 2 Pink Floyd Roses
- 1 Yellow Solidago
- 2 Yellow Button Poms
- Sprigs of Thistle
- 2 Peach Carnations
- 2 Raspberry Scabiosa
- 1-2 Orange Ranunculus
- Sprigs of Pennycress, Variegated Pittosporum, and Israeli Ruscus.

Bouts & Corsages

In the Bright and Cheerful package the bouts can all be different! We typically suggest 1-2 buds per bout, and 3 buds per corsage. Use your greenery of choice! The flowers from this package that work well include: button poms, solidago sprigs, scabiosa, thistle, and ranunculus.

2 Large Ceremony Urns or 2 Large Foam Cages for Arch

Per Urn or Cage:

- 13 Free Spirit Roses
- 13 Pink Floyd Roses
- 10 Yellow Button Poms
- 1 bunch of Leatherleaf Fern
- 1 bunch of Variegated
 Pittosporum



10 Centerpieces with 5-6" Vase Diameter

- 2-3 Free Spirit Roses
- 2-3 Pink Floyd Roses
- 2 Yellow Button Poms broken apart
- Sprigs of Thistle and Solidago
- 2-3 Peach Carnations
- 2 Orange Ranunculus
- Sprigs of Leatherleaf Fern, Pennycress, and Variegated Pittosporum

Recipes for Bright & Cheerful Packages



25-30 Mason Jars -or-3-4" Vase Diameter

- 1 Free Spirit Rose
- 1 Pink Floyd Rose
- 1Yellow Button Poms broken apart
- Sprigs of Thistle and Solidago
- 1Peach Carnation
- 1 Orange Ranunculus
- Sprigs of Leatherleaf Fern,
 Pennycress, and Variegated
 Pittosporum



60-70 Bud Vases

Each one will look different. We average 2-3 blooms per bud vase and a sprig of greenery. These are the flowers allotted for bud vases:

- 25 Free Spirit Roses
- 25 Pink Floyd Roses
- 20 Yellow Solidago
- 20 Yellow Button Poms
- 2 bunches of Thistle
- 25 Peach Carnations
- 20 Orange Ranunculus
- 1 bunch of Leatherleaf Fern, 1 bunch of Pennycress, and 2 bunches of Variegated Pittosporum

Special Care Notes

Special Flower Care Notes for Items Specific to this Package

- **Guard Petals on Roses:** All roses have fugly guard petals that are to be plucked off.
- **Ranunculus**: Have 22 gauge straight floral wire on hand in case they are heavily curved and bending under their own weight. We have a Youtube video on how to do this!
- Carnations: Sometimes these guys can come in closed, but with carnations, you can easily use thumbs to push or 'mash' them open. They are extremely tough and hardy, and the only flower you can manhandle in that way.
- **Poms and Thistle:** As a designer, I often break this product apart to not only make it go further, but to reduce the size and visual weight. I love pulling off lower sprigs to then be used in bouts or a corsage! ≡
- Bug Nibbles: Remember that you are working with unprocessed greenery, so you may find some leaves that have been munched. Just snip those away! Nibbles are typically found on seeded euc and salal predominately.
