

# Recipes for Classic Hydrangea Packages



## Bridal Bouquet

- 5-7 White hydrangeas
- 6-8 White garden roses
- 3 Cream spray roses
- 6-7 White ranunculus
- sprigs of greenery



## Bridesmaid Bouquet

- 2-3 White hydrangeas
- 4-5 White roses
- 1 Spray rose
- sprigs of greenery
- Any leftover garden roses



## Bouts & Corsages

Sprigs of greenery and mini white carnations.  
Save a ranunculus bloom for the groom's bout to make it special!

# Recipes for Classic Hydrangea Packages



## 2 Large Ceremony Urns or 2 Large Foam Cages for Arch

- Per urn or cage:
- First green out with 1 bunch of leatherleaf fern + 1 bunch of silver dollar eucalyptus, then add:
- 10 Hydrangeas
- 13 White roses

Important note: Hydrangeas do not love stand-alone foam. For foam cages, insert the hydrangeas on site, since foam cages do not provide adequate hydration.



## 10 Centerpieces with 5-6" Vase Diameter

- 5 Hydrangeas
- 5 White roses
- 2-3 White carnations
- Sprigs of Leatherleaf fern and seeded eucalyptus

25-30 Mason Jars

-or-

3-4" Vase Diameter

- 2-3 Hydrangeas
- 2-3 White roses
- 1-2 White carnations
- Sprigs of greenery



60-70 Bud Vases

N/A - Hydrangeas are too large for bud vases

# Special Care Notes

## Special Flower Care Notes for Items Specific to this Package

- **Hydrangeas:** These are HEAVY drinkers and do not do well in floral foam alone. Remember to put extra water in your vases and buckets. When you are not carrying around your hydrangea bouquet, please it back in a vase of water.
- **Ranunculus:** Have 22 gauge straight floral wire on hand in case your ranunculus are heavily curved and bending under their own weight. [Learn how to wire ranunculus on this page.](#)
- **Bug Nibbles:** Remember that you are working with unprocessed greenery, so you may find some leaves that have been munched. Just snip those away! Nibbles are typically found on eucalyptus and salal.
