Bridal Bouquet

- 5-6 Mother of Pearl Roses
- 2-3 Pink Ice Protea
- 5 Golden Mustard Roses
- Sprigs of Thistle
- 5 Terracotta Carnations
- 3 Peach Ranunculus
- 2-3 Brown Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Bleached Ruscus, Leather Leaf, and Baby Eucalyptus

Bridesmaid Bouquet

- 2-3 Mother of Pearl Roses
- 1 Pink Ice Protea
- 1 Golden Mustard Rose
- Sprigs of Thistle
- 2-3 Terracotta Carnations
- 1-2 Peach Ranunculus
- 1-2 Brown Lisianthus
- Sprigs of greenery

Bouts & Corsages

Sprigs of thistle, greenery, ranunculus, or lisianthus buds. All will look slightly different

2 Large Ceremony Urns or2 Large Foam Cages for Arch

Per Urn or Cage:

- 13 Terracotta Carnations
- 13 Mother of Pearl Roses
- 2-3 Pink Ice Protea
- 5-6 Golden Mustard Roses
- Sprigs of Thistle
- 1 bunch Baby Eucalyptus
- 1 bunch Leather Leaf



10 Centerpieces with 5-6" Vase Diameter

- 2-3 Mother of Pearl Roses
- 1 Pink Ice Protea
- 2-3 Terracotta Carnations
- Sprigs of Thistle
- 1-2 Golden Mustard Garden Roses
- 2 Peach Ranunculus
- 2 Brown Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Leather Leaf and Baby Eucalyptus

Recipes for Boho Packages



25-30 Mason Jars -or-3-4" Vase Diameter

- 1 Mother of Pearl Rose
- 1 Pink Ice Protea
- 1 Terracotta Carnation
- Sprigs of Thistle
- 1 Golden Mustard Garden Rose
- 1 Peach Ranunculus
- 1 Brown Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Leather Leaf and Baby Eucalyptus



60-70 Bud Vases

Each one will look different. We average 2-3 blooms per bud vase and a sprig of greenery. These are the flowers allotted for bud vases:

- 25 Mother of Pearl Roses
- 10 Pink Ice Protea
- 25 Terracotta Carnations
- 2 bunches of Thistle
- 12 Golden Mustard Garden Roses
- 20 Peach Ranunculus
- 20 Brown Lisianthus
- 3 bunches of Leather Leaf
- 3 bunches of Baby Eucalyptus

Special Care Notes

Special Flower Care Notes for Items Specific to this Package

- Reflex Rose and Lisianthus: We adore reflexing roses and lisianthus! It's a
 baller florist move that gives you more bang for your buck, ESPECIALLY
 when it comes to Golden Mustard Roses. Those guys are pricey and can
 be small, so a little reflexing goes a long way!
- Ranunculus: Have 22 gauge straight floral wire on hand in case they are heavily curved and bending under their own weight. We have a Youtube video on how to do this!
- Carnations: Sometimes these guys can come in closed, but with carnations, you can easily use thumbs to push or 'mash' them open. They are extremely tough and hardy, and the only flower you can manhandle in that way.
