Bridal Bouquet

- 5-6 Brown Toffee Roses
- 3-4 Terracotta Carnations
- 2-3 Peach Cremones
- 5-6 Peach Ranunculus
- 5-6 Golden Mustard Roses
- 3-4 Cream Spray Roses
- Sprigs of Bleached Ruscus, Leather Leaf, and Baby Eucalyptus



Bridesmaid Bouquet

- 2-3 Brown Toffee Roses
- 2-3 Terracotta Carnations
- 1-2 Peach Cremones
- 1-2 Peach Ranunculus
- 2-3 Golden Mustard Rose
- 1 Cream Spray Rose
- Sprigs of Bleached Ruscus, Leather Leaf, and Baby Eucalyptus



Bouts & Corsages

Sprigs of cream spray rose buds, greenery, and save a ranunculus for the groom!

Recipes for Terracotta Packages



2 Large Ceremony Urns or 2 Large Foam Cages for Arch

Per Urn or Cage:

- 13 Brown Toffee Roses
- 13 Terracotta Carnations
- 5 Peach Cremones
- 1 bunch of Leather Leaf
- 1 bunch of Baby Eucalyptus



10 Centerpieces with 5-6" Vase Diameter

- 2-3 Brown Toffee Roses
- 2-3 Terracotta Carnations
- 2 Peach Cremones
- 2-3 Golden Mustard Roses
- 1-2 Cream Spray Roses
- Sprigs of Leather Leaf, Baby Eucalyptus, and Bleached Ruscus

Recipes for Terracotta Packages



25-30 Mason Jars -or-3-4" Vase Diameter

- 1 Brown Toffee Rose
- 1Terracotta Carnation
- 1Peach Cremone
- 1 Cream Spray Rose
- 1 Golden Mustard Rose
- Sprigs of Leather Leaf, Baby Eucalyptus, and Bleached Ruscus



60-70 Bud Vases

Each one will look different. We average 2-3 blooms per bud vase and a sprig of greenery. These are the flowers allotted for bud vases:

- 25 Brown Toffee Roses
- 25 Terracotta Carnations
- 20 Peach Cremones
- 25 Golden Mustard Garden Roses
- 20 Cream Spray Roses
- 3 bunches of Leatherleaf
- 2 bunches of Bleached Ruscus
- 3 bunches of Baby Eucalyptus

Special Care Notes

Special Flower Care Notes for Items Specific to this Package

ATTN: We highly recommend Red Clay and Honeycomb Design Master Floral Spray paint to help with your color story. Buying dried grasses also helps the palette!

- Reflex Roses: We adore reflexing roses! It's a baller florist move that
 gives you more bang for your buck, ESPECIALLY when it comes to
 Golden Mustard Roses. Those guys are pricey and can be small, so a little
 reflexing goes a long way!
- **Ranunculus:** Have 22 gauge straight floral wire on hand in case they are heavily curved and bending under their own weight. We have a Youtube video on how to do this!
- **Carnations**: Sometimes these guys can come in closed, but with carnations, you can easily use thumbs to push or 'mash' them open. They are extremely tough and hardy, and the only flower you can manhandle in that way.
- **Spray Painting Greenery:** Spraying out the greenery with Copper, Red Clay, or Honeycomb Design Master Fresh Floral Spray is a great way to lock down the terracotta vibes!
