Bridal Bouquet

- 4-6 Shimmer Roses
- 4-6 Coral Moviestar Roses
- 3-5 White Carnations
- 3-5 Peach Ranunculus
- 2-3 Coral Spray Roses
- 5-6 White Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Variegated Pittosporum and Israeli Ruscus



Bridesmaid Bouquet

- 2-3 Shimmer Roses
- 2-3 Coral Moviestar Roses
- 2 White Carnations
- 2 Peach Ranunculus
- 1-2 Coral Spray Roses
- 2-3 White Lisianthus
- Sprigs of Variegated Pittosporum and Israeli Ruscus



Bouts & Corsages

1-2 Coral spray rose buds and mini peach carnation bud with sprigs of lisianthus buds and greenery. We like to save a ranunculus for the groom's bout to make his special!

Recipes for Peach and Coral Packages



2 Large Ceremony Urns or 2 Large Foam Cages for Arch

Per Urn or Cage:

- 13 Coral Moviestar Roses
- 13 Peach Carnations
- 1 bunch of Brillantina
- 1 bunch of Variegated Pittosporum



10 Centerpieces with 5-6" Vase Diameter

- 2-3 Coral Moviestar Roses
- 2-3 Shimmer Roses
- 2-3 Peach Carnations
- 2 Peach Ranunculus
- A few White Lisianthus Buds
- Sprigs of Brillantina and Variegated Pittosporum

Recipes for Peach and Coral Packages



25–30 Mason Jars

–or–

3–4" Vase Diameter

- 1 Coral Moviestar Rose
- 1 Shimmer Rose
- 1 Peach Carnation
- 1 Peach Ranunculus
- A few White Lisianthus Buds
- Sprigs of Brillantina and Variegated Pittosporum

**Each one will look different



60–70 Bud Vases

Each one will look different. We average 2–3 blooms per bud vase and a sprig of greenery. These are the flowers allotted for bud vases:

- 25 Coral Moviestar Roses
- 25 Shimmer Roses
- 25 Peach Carnations
- 20 Peach Ranunculus
- 20 White Lisianthus
- 2 bunches of Brillantina
- 3 bunches of Variegated Pittosporum

Special Care Notes

Special Flower Care Notes for Items Specific to this Package

- **Reflex Rose and Lisianthus:** We adore reflexing roses and lisianthus! It's a baller florist move that gives you more bang for your buck!
- **Guard Petals on Roses and Spray Roses:** Fugly petals are a part of the florist hustle, just pluck 'em off!
- **Ranunculus:** Have 22 gauge straight floral wire on hand in case they are heavily curved and bending under their own weight. We have a Youtube video on how to do this!
- **Carnations:** Sometimes these guys can come in closed, but with carnations, you can easily use thumbs to push or 'mash' them open. They are extremely tough and hardy, and the only flower you can manhandle in that way.
