**recipes broken down per bouquet/centerpiece

- <u>**1 Bridal Bouquet:**</u> 2-3 Bronze football mums, 3-5 terracotta carnations, 4-5 burgundy scabiosa, 3-5 copper cushion poms, 3-5 Sahara roses, 3 rubicon spray roses, 3-4 burgundy carnations, sprigs of thistle and golden amaranthus, and sprigs of seeded eucalyptus, nandina, and agonis
- <u>6-7 Bridesmaid Bouquets:</u> 1 Bronze football mums, 2 terracotta carnations, 2 burgundy scabiosa, 2-3 copper cushion poms, 3 Sahara roses, 1 rubicon spray roses, 2-3 burgundy carnations, sprigs of thistle and golden amaranthus, and sprigs of seeded eucalyptus, nandina, and agonis
- <u>Bouts or Corsages:</u> I average 1-2 spray rose buds per bout, and 3 buds per corsage. Add sprigs of thistle, cushion flower, and your favorite green! I like to save a scabiosa for the groom's bout to make his special!
- **2 Large Ceremony Urns or 2 Large Foam Cages for Arch:** Fill out first with 1/2 bunch Salal, 1 bunch Seeded Eucalyptus, 1/2 bunch Agonis, & 1/2 bunch Nandina Fall Foliage. Backfill with 12 burgundy carnations, 5 bronze football mums, 12 Sahara roses, 5 copper cushion flowers per urn or cage
- **10 Centerpieces with a 5-6" Vase Diameter:** 1 bronze football mum, 2-3 sahara roses, 2-3 burgundy carnations, 3 copper cushion flower, sprigs of thistle, 3 burgundy scabiosa, 1 rubicon spray rose, sprigs of seeded eucalyptus, nandina, salal tips, and agonis
- **25-30 Mason Jars or 3-4" Vase Diameter:** 1 bronze football mum, 1 sahara roses, 1 burgundy carnations, 1 copper cushion flower, sprigs of thistle, 1 burgundy scabiosa, 1 rubicon spray rose, sprigs of seeded eucalyptus, nandina, salal tips, and agonis
- 60-70 Budvases: Each one will look different. I average 2-3 blooms per bud vase and a sprig of green. These are the flower allotted for budvases: 10 bronze football mum, 25 sahara roses, 25 burgundy carnations, 30 copper cushion flower, 20 stems of thistle, 30 burgundy scabiosa, 10 rubicon spray rose, 2 bunches of seeded eucalyptus, 1 nandina, 1 salal tip, and 1 agonis

SPECIAL FLOWER CARE NOTES FOR ITEMS SPECFIC TO THIS PACKAGE:

- **Reflex Roses:** We adore reflexing roses and lisianthus! It's a baller florist move that gives you more bang for your buck, ESPECIALLY when it comes to Golden Mustard Roses. Those guys are pricey and can be small, so a little reflexing goes a long way!
- **Scabiosa**: Leave the straws on the stem to support the head. Also, it's not uncommon to have unbloomed buds.
- Football Mums: Gently remove netting on bloom. Keep in cool location.
- **Golden Amaranthus**: The foliage on amaranthus is always whack and should be snipped off. But it's ok, we don't love it for it's leaves!
- **Cushion Flowers**: As a designer, I love to cut these apart when placing in my designs. It makes the product go further, and avoids too much visual weight, as there are typically 4-7 buds per stem.
- **Carnations:** Sometimes these guys can come in closed, but with carnations, you can easily use thumbs to push or 'mash' them open. They are extremely tough and hardy, and the only flower you can manhandle in that way.
