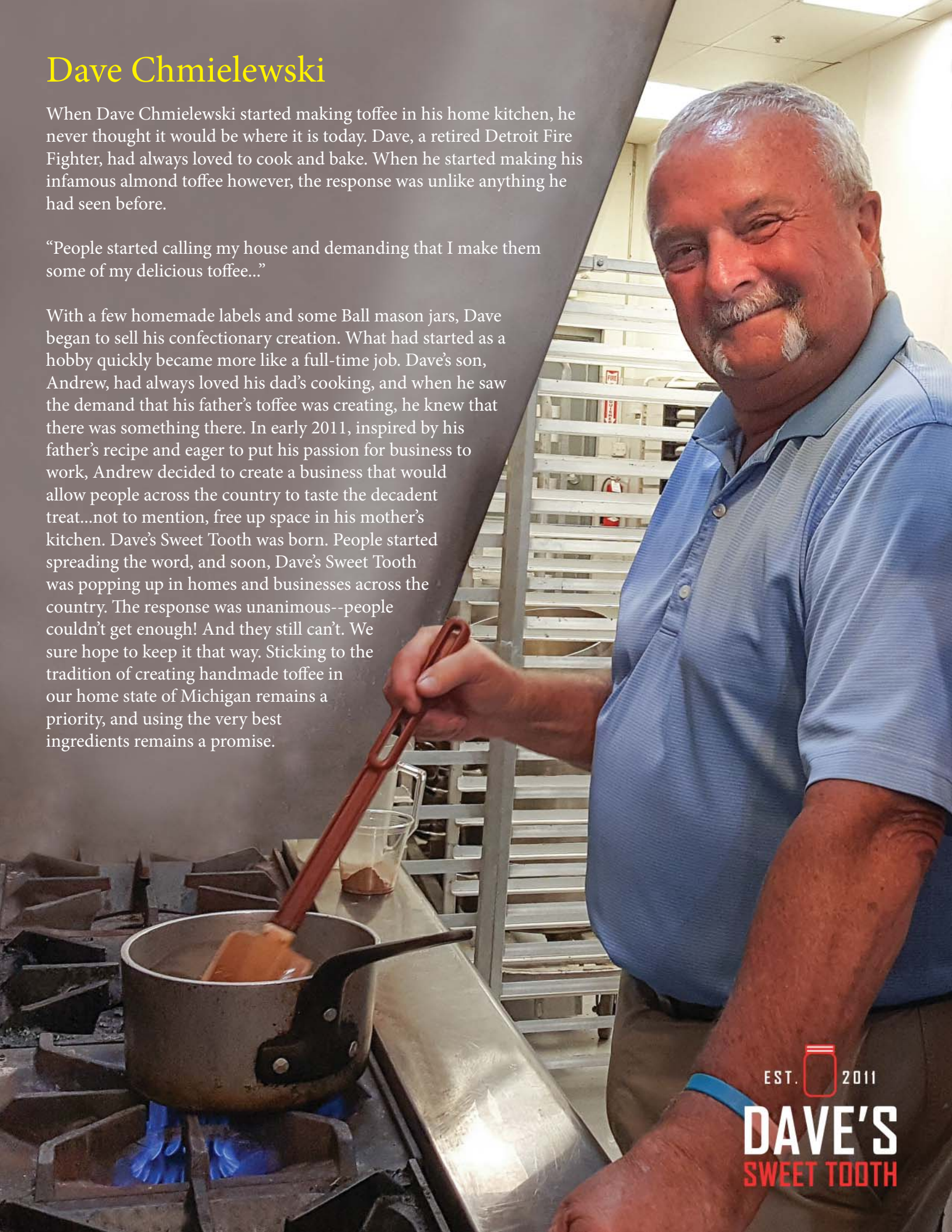


Dave Chmielewski
