PRODUCT HANDLING

- Dissolve a tea cup full of Soaking Powder in 10L of cold water.
- Submerge cutleries, cups, mugs, dishes, etc.
- Leave to soak for at least 20 minutes then remove and rinse thoroughly with fresh water.
- For Ice Cream Machines, allow the solution through the lines a few times, then rinse twice with fresh water.
- For coffee machines, add the powder in the machine filter, run the machine 5 to 7 times. Then run the machine with fresh water for a good rinse before normal use.
