
SHIRTS SIZING

To find your shirt size, use your neck and sleeve measurements. If you are in between sizes, choose the larger size.

NECK: Place 0" mark of the tape measure in the center of your neck. Tape should wrap around the neck, under the chin resting comfortably at your collar line, back to the center front of neck. Tape should be laid flat, held neither too tight, nor too loose. The point where the tape meets the 0" mark (in the center front of the neck) is your measurement.



SLEEVE: To measure your
sleeve length, start at the
center of the back below
the back of the neck, and
measure the distance to the
shoulder seam. Next, measure
the distance from shoulder
seam to bottom of cuff.
Finally, add these two
numbers to get your sleeve
length.

When taking these measurements, use a cloth tape measure, not a metal one.
