How to measure your ring size

Step 1 Firstly cut around the ring sizer
Step 2 Carefully cut the line B to create a slit
Step 3 Pull A through gab B
Step 4 Place the paper loop around the finger (as you would a ring), then pull A so that it is not too tight around the area you want the ring to sit. It is important to note that if your knuckles are prominent, make sure to read the size that passes over them.
Step 5 Read your finger's size. The number should pass exactly through gap B.
This number is the Italian ring size.
Kindly consult the size chart to find your size in the corresponding US or international sizing scheme. Note that it could be 1-2 sizes off but is a useful method if you have no general idea of your size. Instead, we recommend sizing your ring using a mandrel and rings you already own. These can be easily found online or at your local jeweler's.
