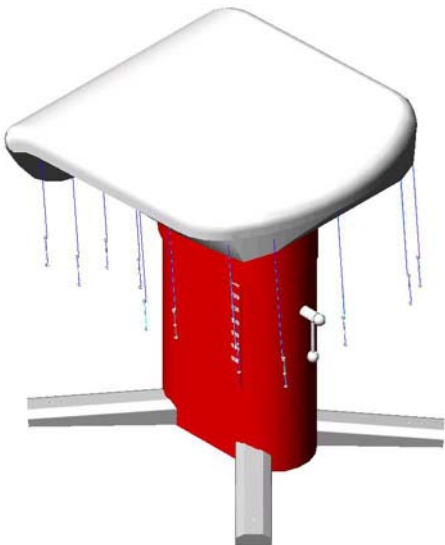


Instructions for the installation of a replacement cover on Pegasus

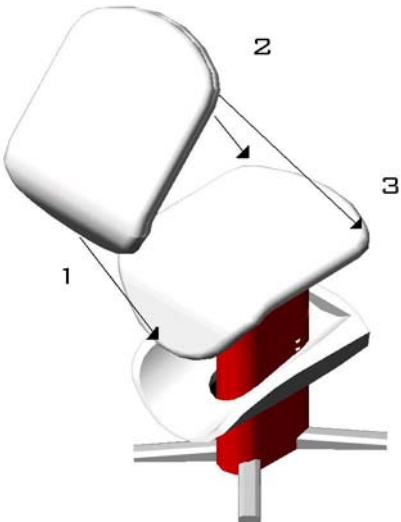

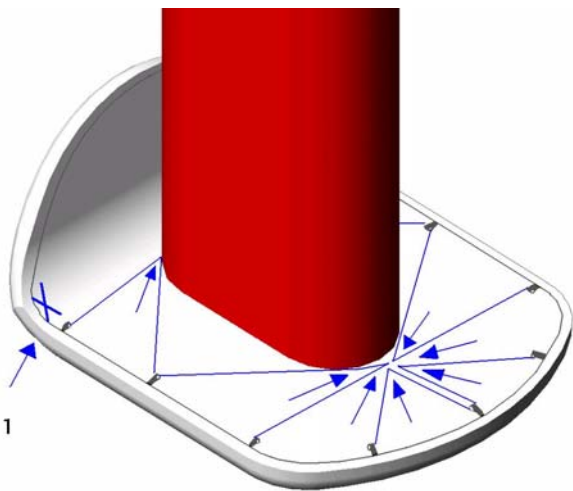

1. Set Pegases in the highest position. (135 cm)
Remove all screws at the bottom of the grey polyester bowl.
(figure A)
2. Lower the grey bowl. (figure B)
Remove the damaged cover and all staples completely from the top.
Remove all dirt and fluff from the foam.
3. Install the replacement cover in the following order:
Pull the cover over the foam, starting at the front (1) and placing the seam of the cover exactly on the edge of the foam. Then pull the corners (2 and 3) of the cover over the foam making sure that all seams are exactly on the edges of the foam. (figure C)
4. Tighten the elastic cord at the bottom of the cover, pulling at two ends and starting at (1). Tighten the remainder of the elastic cord crosswise using the hooks.
Make sure that the seams of the cover stay on the edges of the foam and avoid folds.
Leave it for 24 hours to let the fabric set to the shape of the top.
Afterwards tighten the cover once more, check for folds making sure that the seams of the cover remain on the edges of the foam.
Correct if necessary. (figure D)
5. Re-install the grey bowl and all screws. (figure A)
