





TERROIR DRIVEN

MERLOT

Region: Great Southern Variety: Merlot 100%



WINEMAKING

Fruit is harvested and crushed into small open fermenters. The cap is plunged by hand three to four times a day to obtain gentle extraction of fine grained and silky tannins. Post fermentation the wine is run off into French oak barrels, 25% being new, for 15 months maturation. The wine is pumped into tank prior to bottling before being gently fined (egg white) and filtered.

COLOUR

Bright, mid to deep ruby red.

AROMA

Lifted aromas of plum and cranberry with underlying spicy, French oak.

PALATE

Dry, fine tannin and beautifully balanced French oak that provides structure for the varietal fruit flavours of cherry and cranberry. A well integrated and complete example of Merlot with terrific length of flavour.
