RING SIZING GUIDE

We have created this guide to help you, but ring sizing is hard to determine accurately from a paper printout. To be absolutely sure of your size you should be measured by your local jeweler. We cannot be responsible for conversion errors, paper sizer malfunctions, typos, or any other ring sizing mistakes made on your end.

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Before you print this page, make sure to uncheck all “scale to print” boxes, and ensure that “page scaling” is set to “none” on your print dialog box.

Use a ring that fits you just the way you like on the finger you intend to wear the ring. Place it over the circles below to find your size. Match the inside diameter of the ring to the circle’s outline.

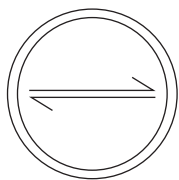
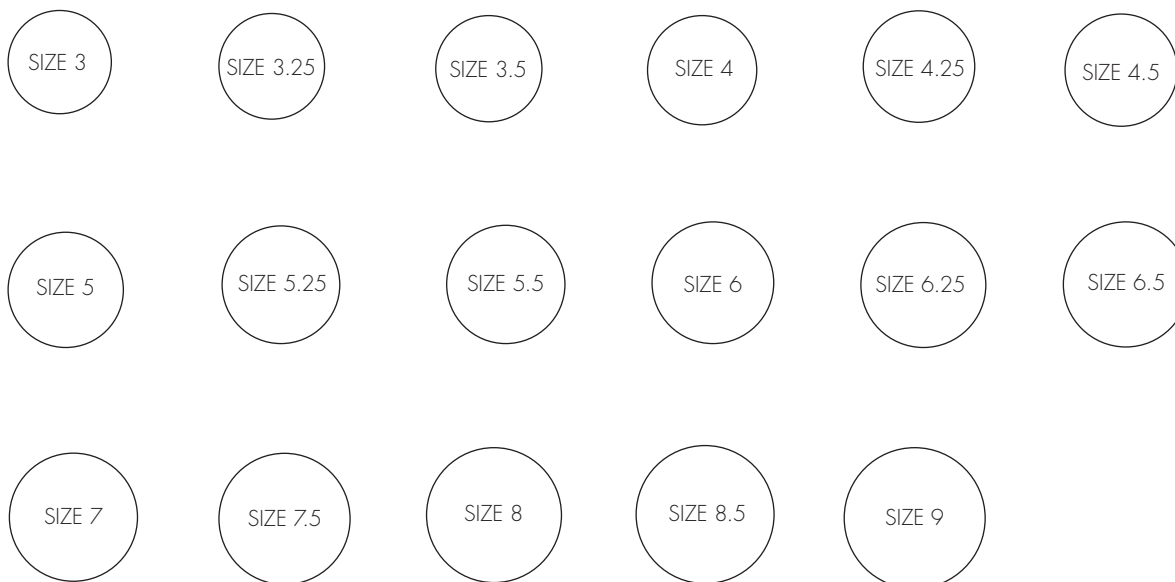
TIPS FOR MEASURING YOUR RING SIZE

For best results use a plain thin band. Do not use string to measure your ring size as it stretches and could be inaccurate. As a reminder, each of your fingers is a different size; a ring worn on your left hand will not fit the matching finger on your right hand. If buying a wide band we suggest ordering on the larger size. Use a ring that fits perfectly on the desired finger.



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RING SIZING CHART



Use only the inside of the ring, when you measure.



Measure this line, it needs to be exactly 1 inch.

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

To get the best results, you will need to check your printer settings and ensure that the 'page scaling' option is set to 'none'. This page must be printed on a full letter size page (8.5 X 11 inches).

To verify that the page is calibrated correctly, measure the sample below. It should measure 1 inch.

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HOW TO USE THE RING SIZER

To find your ring size, print this page and match one of the circles below with the inside of your rings. Half sizes are determined if your ring size falls between two of the circles.

Please note that this size guide is for approximate sizing only and is not meant to be exact.
