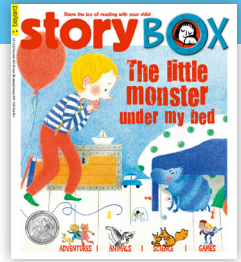


The little monster under my bed
