

### STEP 1



Knead dough until it's warm and soft. This may take a minute or two.

### STEP 2



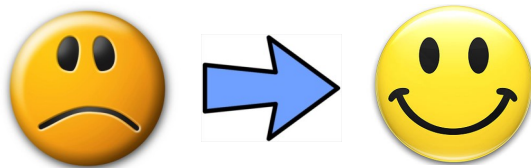
On a sheet of foil, roll the dough to about 1/4 to 1/2 inch thickness. You will want enough room for a 1/4 inch border around the print. If roller sticks, rub some baby oil on it from the pad. Keep dough as flat and smooth as possible.

### STEP 3



Use baby oil-soaked pad and apply oil to hand, foot, or paw. Firmly press hand/foot/paw into the dough. Deeper prints capture the best detail. However, be careful not to press all the way through. Be sure to have some space between each finger for handprints. It may help to push each finger in individually.

### STEP 4



We know how kids/pets can be sometimes, and things may not be perfect the first time around. If the print doesn't turn out how you want, simply repeat steps 1-4 as many times as it takes to get the perfect print. This is important because your final product will look exactly like the print you capture.

### STEP 5



Bake at 275 for 10 minutes, then allow to cool. Put the child/pet's first and last name on the back with marker for each print completed. These names are very important as they help us keep prints organized.

### STEP 6



Place the baked print, order form (if you did not complete online), and roller into the pre-paid envelope. No extra wrap or packaging required, the bubble envelope provides plenty of protection for the print. Drop it off in the mail and wait 4-6 weeks for your final product.
