We will not be able to begin the final product until the forms are received. Here are a few tips that you may find helpful:

Tips for everyone

- We will send you a confirmation email when we receive your prints back. Shipping confirmation will be emailed to you when the final product leaves our shop.
- Because of our detailed process, and the time it takes the clay to dry, the final product will arrive back to you in 4 to 6 weeks. Unfortunately, when using the kiln, about 5% of our products come out with blemishes or cracks that cause the process to restart. If there are any unusual delays that will not allow us to get the product to you on time, we will contact you.
- We can create many products with a single mold. If you would like to add to your order, please contact us. Memories In Clay offers a number of premium customized items. Please check out our website for the most current selection. We keep molds for a year if you desire additional products.

Tips for capturing baby prints:

- You may need two adults for babies that are not cooperating. One will hold the child while the other will press the hand/foot into the molding material.
- To help relax a baby's hand, gently stroke the back of the hand just before pressing into the molding material. This is especially helpful if they are making a fist with their hand instead of spreading their fingers.

Tips for capturing dog prints:

- Treats can be very helpful
- You may need two adults for dogs that are not cooperating
- If you have a new puppy or very small dog (typically 10 pounds or less), you can try to capture both prints. If they fit on our standard product, we will include them both on your finished product.

Doing Multiple Prints?

- For 2 print sibling plaques, have 1 person do the right hand, and the other use their left.
- If you are doing a 2 print plaque with a hand and a foot, use opposite hand and foot. For example, right hand and left foot.
- For Mommy and Me or Daddy and Me Plaques, both parent and child should use the same hand.
- If you are doing a large family serving tray, or some other large family product, mix it up. Have some people use their right hand and others use their left.
