Knit the Perfect Heel – Cuff Down [NEW]

In this 3-hour class, you will learn to knit a sock heel that fits perfectly. We begin by taking exacting measurements, followed by some applicable calculations to create a specific formula for a precise heel flap and gusset. Jana's method is easy to follow for even knitters that hate math! We'll figure it all out together and there will be plenty of time to ask questions and get help. Knitters will leave this class knowing exactly how to knit the perfect heel for anyone with any size yarn. You will knit a cuff and sock leg before attending class. You choose whether you want shortie socks or a full-length sock leg. We will focus on knitting a heel for a precise fit, so coming to class with completed homework is essential. A handout will be provided beforehand with links to video tutorials.
