To secure your bag:

- You will need four bolts, four nuts and eight washers. (They are not included in this package) We suggest that you use 6mm or 1/4 in. bolts approximately 14 in. long, a self-locking nut or Loctite and large O. D. fender washers, one inside the bag and one under the fender.
- Drill holes in your fender as far apart as the fender and bag will allow
- Using a soldering iron or punch, make holes in the bottom of the bag to match the holes in your fender.
