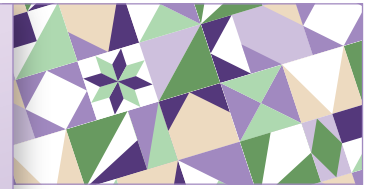

Made using Studio 180 Design's Large Square Squared® & Birds of Paradise Tech Sheet



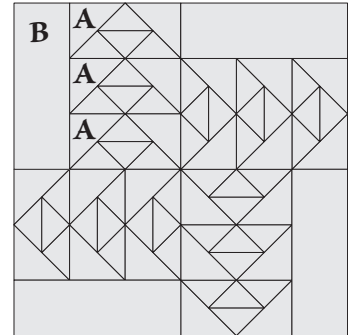

All the instruction you need to make the units required for this block can be found on the Birds of Paradise Technique Sheet. There are charts, step by step graphics, and directions. Use the chart to find the information you need for the finished size of the unit you want to make. Then work your way through the instructions.

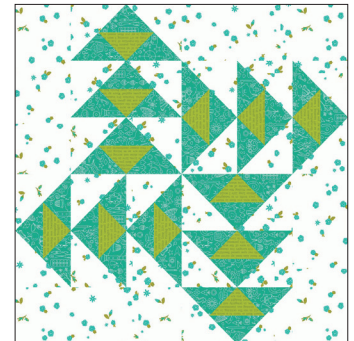
I've always loved the Dutchman's Puzzle block, and thought it would look great using Birds of Paradise. Then I decided to add the extra units on the outside for additional pizzazz, and I just loved the result. I hope you do too! There are many design opportunities available to you with this block. We've added a line drawing so you can get out your colored pencils and have some fun! Remember that when you cut your squares used for Colors 1, 2, and 3, you get four triangles from a square so take some time before you start to cut to add up the number of triangles of each color you want and divide that by 4 to see how many squares of each fabric you need to cut.

When you make your Birds of Paradise units, remember that you will trim the square made with the Color 1 and 2 triangles using the window template of the Large Square Squared®. The size window template that you will use comes from the column on the technique sheet called "Ruler Part A Center Square Trim Lines".



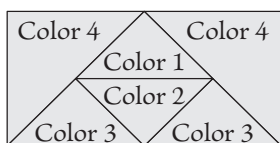

B: Rectangles	4	1½" x 3½" cut size	2½" x 6½" cut size	3½" x 9½" cut size

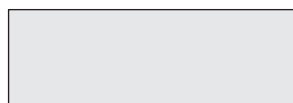


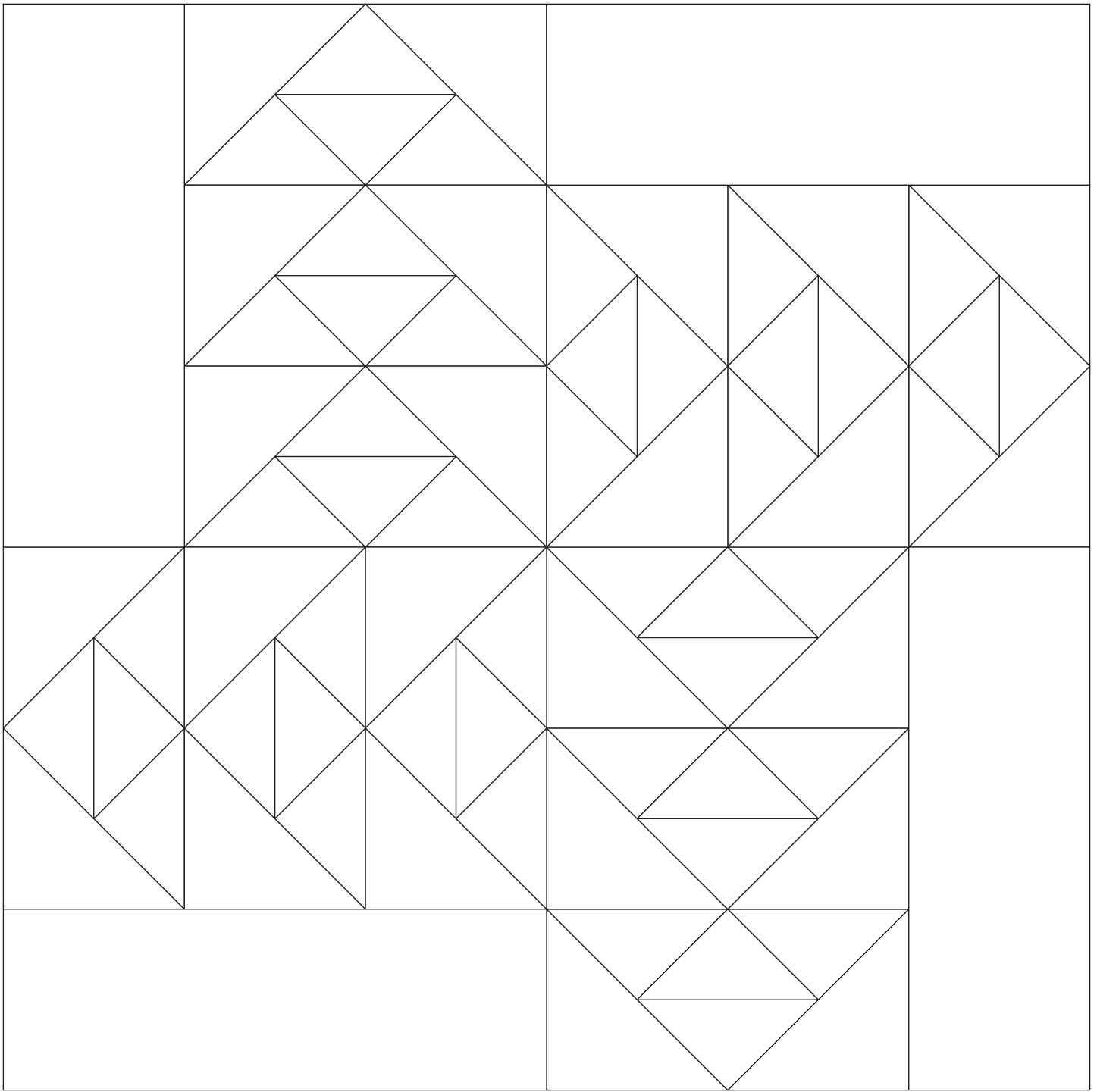
