
Rolling Stone Made using the Square Squared®



Difficulty:

All the instructions you need to make the Square Squared[®] units required for this block came with your Square Squared[®]. There's a chart, step by step graphics, and directions. Determine the finished size you are making and then work your way through the instructions.

When making your block you can either cut individual squares for your four patch and double square units or you can strip piece them to make it easier depending on your fabric choices. To strip piece your four patch and double square units cut your fabrics the given width for your desired block size, then stitch the two strips together lengthwise, press as desired. You will then sub-cut the pieced strip the suggested width of the squares; you will need to make six cuts. For example if you are making the 6" finished block you will cut two strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10" and then stitch together, clean up one edge and sub-cut every 1½" down the strip till you have made six cuts, with just a little left over.










Cutting Chart

A: Square Squared	4	1" finished size 1½" cut size	2" finished size 2½" cut size	4" finished size 4½" cut size
B: Squares	12	1" square cut size	1½" square cut size	2½" square cut size
C: Rectangle	4	1" x 1½" rectangle cut size	1½" x 2½" rectangle cut size	2½"x 4½" rectangle cut size
