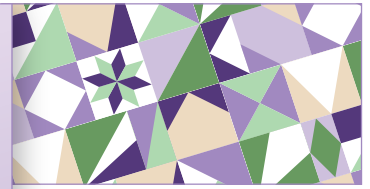

Tool and Eight at Once Technique Sheet

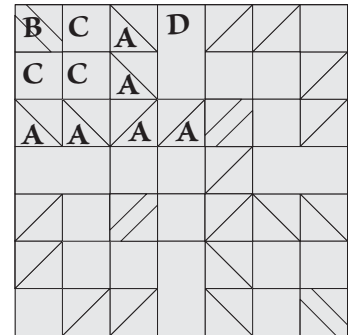

All the information you need to make the units in this block can be found in the instructions that came with your **Tucker Trimmer® I** tool and on the Eight at Once technique sheet. There are charts, step by step graphics, and directions. Use the chart to find the information you need for the finished size of the units you want to make and follow it through to find what you need to cut to make those units. Then work your way through the instructions. That's all there is to it!

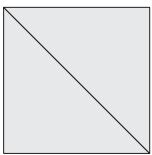
To make your stems, you will need your stem fabric and the background fabric. Cut the rectangles and squares listed in the chart for your block size. Cut the background squares in half once on the diagonal to create triangles. Stitch a triangle to either side of the stem rectangle. You can just center them as they are oversized so you can trim them. Press the seams toward the triangles. To trim the stems, position the **Common Diagonal** of the **Tucker Trimmer® I** down the center of the stem. You can just eyeball it. Close is good enough, as no one will be able to tell if it isn't quite down the center. Trim two sides, rotate, align the clean up lines for the cut size of your unit, and trim to size. Refer to the two images at the bottom of the page.

This is a great time to use your Eight at Once technique sheet, as you are making so many half square triangles. But if you don't have it, you can always make them two at a time and make your block scrappy.

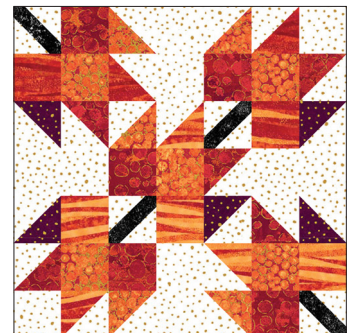
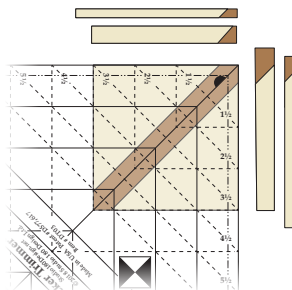
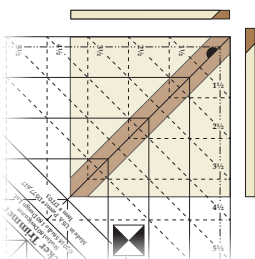
