All the instruction you need to make the units required for this block can be found in the instructions that came with your Square Squared ${ }^{\oplus}$ and Tucker Trimmer ${ }^{\ominus}$ I tools, and on the Little Houses technique sheet. There are charts, step by step graphics, and directions. Use the chart to find the information you need for the finished size of the unit you want to make. Then work your way through the instructions.

I don't have much to say this month, since this block is easy to put together. There are not difficult seams to match or tricky steps. This month would be a great one for you to play with color placement. Depending on how many different fabrics you use and where you place the fabric you can get a block that looks very different from what I have made.
